

Blood Battle: "BEST" OF CARE FOR MAYOR

Georgetown's mayor Bill Smith got the 'Best' of care when he made his donation at the Mayors' Challenge blood clinic here Monday. That's Milton mayor Brian Best providing the bedside manner. Positions will be changed at Milton's blood clinic in January.

Four hundred and fortyfour people attended the Monday clinic of which 39 were rejected for a total donation of 405 blood packs. There were 43 new donors.

About 1,000 registered donors were contacted prior to the clinic in a letter from

the Georgetown mayor who has challenged other Halton communities to equal Georgetown's blood donation.

In last year's December clinic 367 offered blood, and 342 were accepted. There were 39 new donors at that




