

Georgetown Cabbies Lost Money Sunday

A letter, supported by the day's work sheet, showed committee of council Thursday night, Georgetown taxi owners lost \$21.32 by operating last Sunday.

Council had asked the three owners to explain their Sunday closing position.

The taxi owners stated they are now working between 70 and 96 hours a week, because they cannot get help. They pointed out they had advertised for three weeks, but the applicants all backed out when they found out the length of time taken to investigate them and issue a taxi driver's license.

TEMPORARY

The taxi drivers have complained for some time about the fact there are no temporary licenses here, when there are in other municipalities. The temporary license would be in force while the permanent one is being processed.

They also sought a lowering of the insurance demands set out by council in the proposed by-law. Council is asking for \$200,000 insurance. Cr. Ern Hyde felt \$50,000 the amount set by the province was sufficient.

Cr. Ernie Sykes emphasized they could not ask the men to operate at a loss.

SAME DAY

Cr. Donna Denison stated temporary licenses are issued in Toronto. "And the men can start driving taxi the same day", she added. She pointed out that the taxi owners would still be careful who they hired, since they had an investment in the cars.

Cr. Ern Hyde suggested temporary licenses should be issued to an applicant who has lived in the town for six months, and has a chauffeur's license.

When Cr. Denison agreed with him, there were remarks around the table such as "This has never happened before". The by-law will be reworded to cover the three controversial points.



NORTH HALTON REPORT

Police officers from North Halton Detachment of the Ontario Provincial Police worked a total of 92 1/2 hours and patrolled 8,810 miles during the week ending December 6, 1971. Summonses were issued to 29 motorists for traffic violations and an additional 25 drivers received warnings. Convictions registered in Halton Provincial Court numbered 80.

There were 45 general occurrences which required investigation. Included in this number were: 4 thefts, 1 person charged for violating the Liquor Control Act, 2 persons reported missing and later located, 2 incidents of damage to property and 1 person charged with assault. The remaining occurrences were minor in nature. Improvement in the area of traffic collisions must be noted this week. The number and severity of this week's collisions is less than in previous weeks. Sixteen vehicles were involved in 12 collisions with damage

estimated to total \$4,120.00. Two collisions resulted in injury to 2 people with remaining collisions causing property damage only. Five drivers have been charged as a result of being involved in these collisions. The causes of these collisions have been attributed to: inattentive driving, speed too fast for road or traffic conditions, improper turns, driver lost control and impaired driving.

Provincial Constable J. H. L. Redpath, North Halton Detachment Accident Prevention Officer, visited Brookville Public School speaking to 333 students about safety.

Everyone knows that roadways become more slippery when wet. But knowing the danger doesn't always lead to doing something about it. According to a study by the Texas Highway Department 85 per cent of drivers average 3 m.p.h. faster on wet roads than on dry roads. Such people should have their tread examined.
