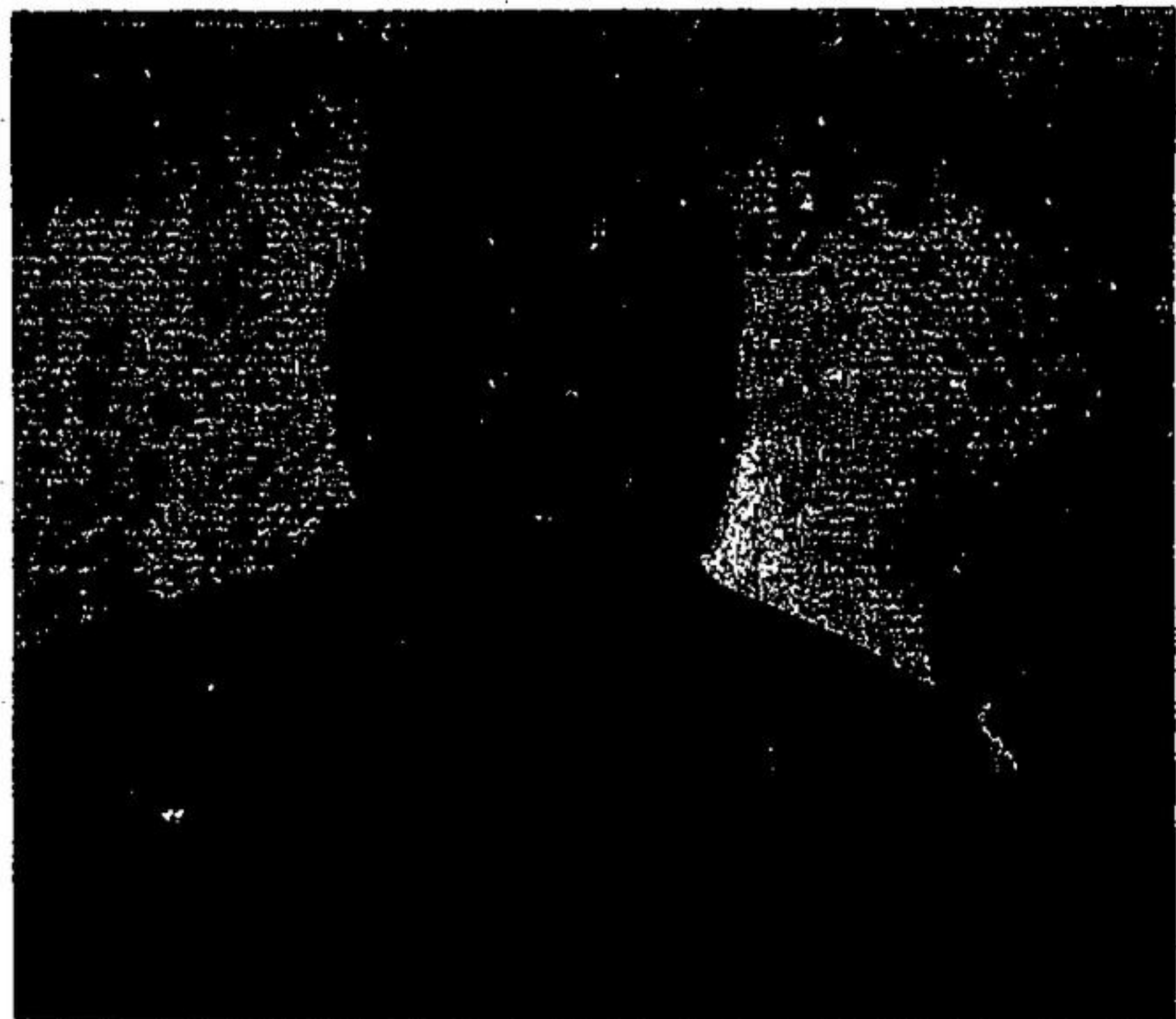

## The YUL-BOCK or GOAT



A Christmas Yule-bock is familiar to the children of Scandinavian countries. In Sweden, the children are told that the Yule ram will butt them if they are disobedient, however this doesn't seem to frighten them very much. They regard him with great affection. Along with Christmas candles in these countries, you can usually see a small straw goat.

In Norway they leave food out for the Julebuk. If he ignores it, it means that the ram has been offended in some way, and this is considered a bad omen. Sometimes they will find grain in the dish, and this will mean a good crop year is ahead. In some Norwegian homes the Julebuk truly comes into the living room for a surprise visit on the Yule Eve with the Julenisser riding on his back.

In Denmark, the Klapper-bock as they call him, usually consists of a pole which the rider straddles like a hobby-horse. A great skin and a head fashioned of paper or wood make the animal realistic enough to cause lots of fun among the children.

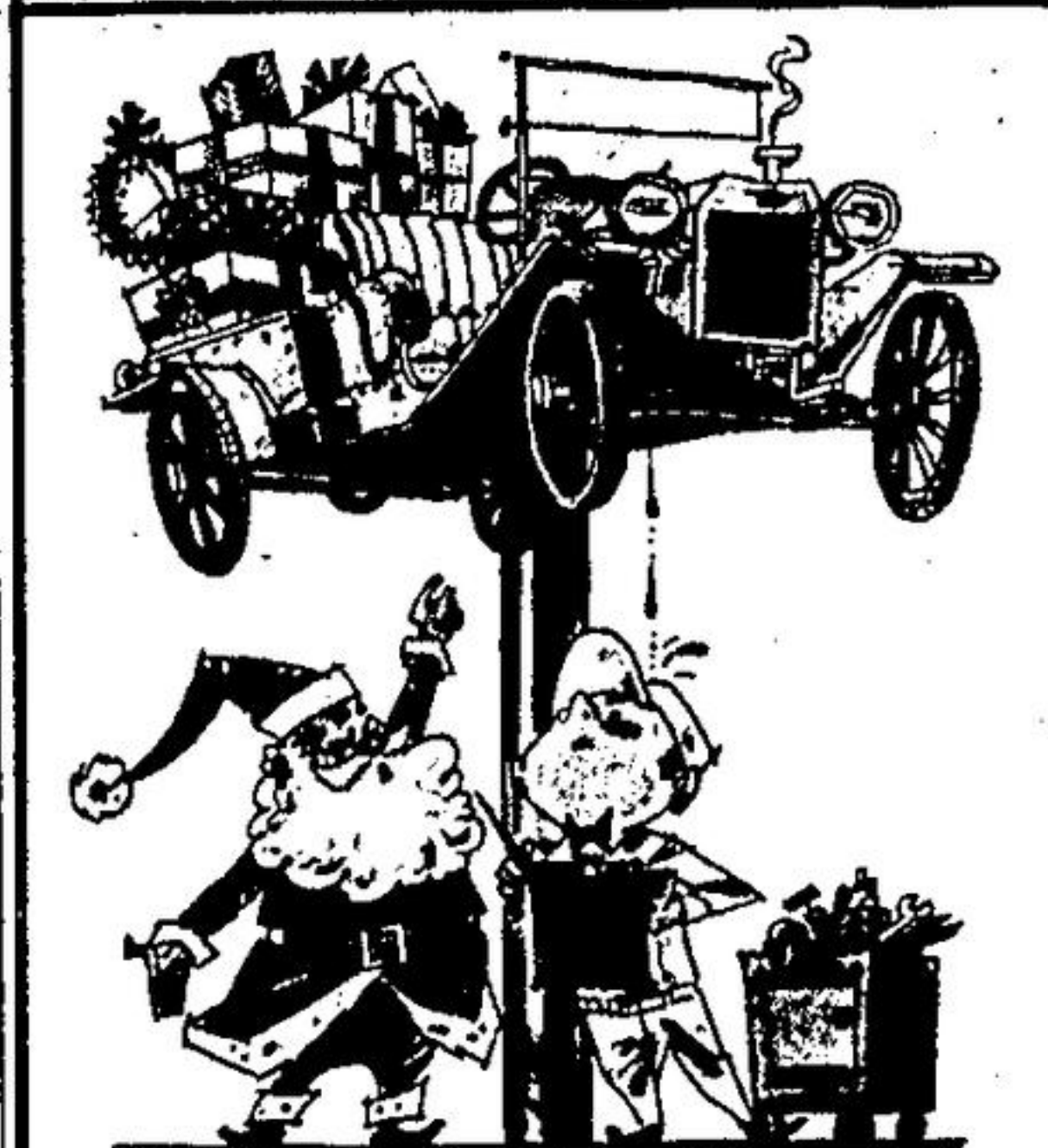
