
# Proposed 15 Storey Building Would Have 170 Apartments

A 15 storey apartment, with sauna, swimming pool and tennis courts, is planned for land on Main Street North, just over the White bridge.

The 2.5 scres of land are owned by R. C. M. Developments, which includes Roy, Cyril and Mac Swim who operate Swim Laboratories on the site, and own the brick house there which was formerly used as a nursing home.

Both the building, and the house will be demolished if the proposed apartment building is approved.

WILL PLANT SCREEN The triangular piece of land is bounded by Main Street North, Carruthers Road, and the CNR track, so the high rise will not block out the sunshine from any adjacent homes.

Shrubbery will be planted along the railway tracks, partly as a sight screen and partly as a sound screen.

170 APARTMENTS A gymnasium and laundry will be on the same level and underground parking for 195 cars, there will also be outside parking for 60 cars.

A very large percentage of the land, 76.42 percent will be left in open space, plus another 4 percent will be children's play

The 170 apartments will be made up of 85 single bedroom and 85 two bedroom apartments.




