**Etobicoke Controller Was Native of Norval**

A Norval man who held high office in Etobicoke, died at Queen'sway General Hospital, December 17, of a heart attack.

Donald Robert Russell, 64, senior Etobicoke controller since 1966, had just been appointed 1972 chairman of the Metro works committee.

He entered municipal politics in 1948 as a New Toronto school trustee. In 1953 he won a council seat and was later mayor of New Toronto for 12 years prior to amalgamation with Etobicoke in 1966. Since then he had been a controller.

Mr. Russell was born on a farm at Norval, son of William and Margaret McEachern Russell. He attended Norval public school and Georgetown high school and graduated in 1932 as a pharmacist from the University of Toronto.

After working in Windsor for a short time, he opened his own store on Lake Shore Boulevard, later adding a second store on Burnhamthorpe Road. His son and daughter-in-law, both pharmacists, manage the two stores.

He was a member of Lakeshore Lions Club, Anthony Sayer Masonic Lodge, Mimico, Chapter 215, R.A.M., Moore Consistory, Rameaux Temple and Royal Order of Jesters.

He leaves his wife, Dorothy Reynolds, two children, Robert and Beverley (Mrs. J. Burton) of New Toronto, grandchildren Donald James and Kimberley Anne Burton; two brothers and a sister, James Russell and Margaret Russell, Norval, and John Russell, New Toronto.

Following funeral service in Century United Church December 20, burial was in Hillcrest Cemetery, Norval, where the committal service was conducted by Rev. Howard Smith of Norval Presbyterian Church.

**Employed With Abitibi Firm for 33 Years**

Employed with Abitibi Provincial Paper Ltd. for 33 years when he retired in 1961, Thomas Herbert, 76, of 11 Temple Road, December 10, in Georgetown hospital.

Mr. Herbert then joined the hospital staff, where he was an employee until 1969.

Born at Crick, near Rugby, England, he was the son of Harry and Emily Castell Herbert. He served with the British army in World War I.

In 1927, he married Elsie May Hull at Abbots Langley, Herts, and they emigrated to Canada, settling in Georgetown. He was a member of St. George's Anglican Church, Branch 120, Canadian Legion and the Imperial Section, and the Abitibi Quarter Century Club. He was fond of fishing and gardening and was a keen cribbage player. He had been a member of the Lorne Scots Band and Georgetown Citizens Band.

He leaves his wife, one son Maurice, two grandchildren, Diane and Karen Herbert, and sisters Mrs. Rose Additt and Mrs. Emily George of Crick. He was predeceased by brothers Arthur of town and William of Crick and a sister, Mrs. Lillian Scott of Detroit, Michigan.

Rev. Robert Gallagher conducted the funeral service at the McClure-Jones Funeral Home, with interment in Greenwood Cemetery. Pallbearers were William Malham of Hamilton, Herbert Arnold, Harry Shortill, Enrico Caruso, Roger Schofield and Orval-Paul.
