Rables is a disease communicable to man and is the concern of the Federal Govern-Department Agriculture, Health of Animals Branch and, of course, the Medical Health Officers of the country. Few diseases are more frightening.

Some years ago the Ontario Humane Society reached the conclusion that the real danger to the general public lay in the possibility of rables becoming common-place in the pet animal population, particularly dogs and


