

Self Estimate Program For Sorority Meeting

Zeta Alpha Chapter, Beta Sigma Phi, held their first meeting of the new year on January 4th in the home of Mrs. Dorothy Zebede. The sorority's plans regarding service projects, ways and means endeavours, social outings and cultural programs for the next few months were discussed during the business meeting.

The program "Self Estimate" was presented by Mrs. June Campbell and Mrs. Lorison Helmer, who opened their program with the quote by Randolph Sailer "It might be claimed in the last analysis the only thing that really matters is the degree of happiness felt by living beings. Such feelings can be judged only by the one who possesses it."

Each member was then asked to give a short statement on what she asks from life, whether it be money, comfort, skill in work or art, health, fame, social distinction, power or love.

The majority asked for good health first, feeling that without good health the chances of obtaining the others are limited.

Mrs. Helmer and Mrs. Campbell then set up debate teams, with the topic for debate being, "Do you believe that all things work together for good?" Approximately half the group agreed with this statement.

To conclude the program the members set up three separate discussion groups. Group 1 was to list ways in which happiness may be cultivated. Group 2 was asked to list seven points either for or against the statement "How much control do you believe you have over your own happiness?" Group 3 was asked to suggest how each of the following impediments to personal happiness may be overcome, loneliness, boredom, despondency, embarrassment, disappointment, restlessness, worry and impatience.
