Potential Danger if Odds, Ends in Garage

The opening meeting for the year of Georgetown's Local Council of Women was held last Friday in the committee room of the Canada Trust building. Mrs. Floria Nodwell presided in the absence of the president, Mrs. Poullos, opening the meeting with a call for silent prayer. Routine business followed after which Mrs. C. B. Dick presented the home economics report, which included excerpts from the current Consumer News. This elicited some discussion on local collection of some types of materials formerly regarded as waste, but not reclaimable, and about which Mrs. Dick will seek further information. Two books were recommended, "Canadian Women and the Law" and "The Great American Food Hoax". Mrs. J. Nieuwof gave the safety report, the first part of which dealt with different prevalent forms of pollution, all detrimental to public health, and all not generally recognized.

There was also a warning in connection with some household articles, universally advertised and used, but with built-in hazards for the user. The report concluded with an admonition about the overloaded garage, which can be a potential source of danger, and a source of many injuries. Garages are not a workshop or storeroom, she said, though frequently used as such. General clutter contributes to accident. Her report concluded with the question "Do you need to keep all the things you are hoarding? Discard them, and you may really find room for your car". Mrs. Nodwell reviewed a number of recently received articles from headquarters of the Provincial Council of Women, concluding with the provincial treasurer's report, indicative of a healthy financial position. Mrs. Walker moved a vote of thanks to the tea hostesses, Mrs. Nodwell and Mrs. Anne Pritchard.

Urge Garbage Disposal On County-Wide Basis

County council's administration committee has recommended to council a garbage disposal study for all of Halton County and a council subcommittee to co-ordinate it. The subcommittee would include officials from all seven Halton municipalities. Committee chairman Allan Masson said "the study is one of the very important keystone parts of regional thinking for Halton County". Warden James Swanborough, said the county should push the study and get to work on it as quickly as possible. Environment Minister George Kerr, Halton West MPP, has suggested that a county-wide study would be the best arrangement and that the environment department would give the greatest subsidies possible for such a study.

COULD SAVE MONEY
If council approves the study, the county will ask Kerr for details of available subsidies. Georgetown reeve Rick Morrow suggested the county's Technical Co-ordinating Committee (TECO) could do a lot of work and save money for the county. TECO could compile details of existing facilities into a report to be handed to the consultant. Swanborough said the county subcommittee would not go ahead immediately with hiring a consultant but might have its municipal representatives prepare the preliminary reports. Swanborough suggested the county-wide study might cost as little as \$10,000 more than the \$50,000 total for Burlington and Oakville.
