40 Species Sighted

Georgetown Bird Count Included Robin, Crows

If you spot a robin in the backyard don't go rushing your furs into cold storage - it may be the non conforming red-breast spied by members of the Georgetown Naturalists' Club on their annual bird counting project.

Facts contained in a news release from the club Tuesday indicate some of the traditional migrants skipped the visit to the sunny south this winter.

The count, made by 13 spotters December 27 in a seven and a half mile radius around Georgetown, included one robin, four crows, and 33 ducks as well as the normal stay-at-homes.

Most frequently counted bird was the starling of which 330 were recorded. House sparrows were next at 253.

Species of which only one member was sighted include the robin, great blue heron, red-shouldered hawk, yellow-bellied sapsucker, winter wren, and Oregon junco.

Club members Mr. and Mrs. G. Langfield, Mr. and Mrs. C. Hildebrandt, N. Cramp, Mrs. F. Brown, Mrs. M. Dewdney, Mr. and Mrs. R. Hansen, and Mr. and Mrs. R. Gauthier were joined by guest bird-watchers Mr. and Mrs. William Findlay of Carleton Place in making the census. Other results were received from members who counted and reported birds at feeding stations.

In all, 40 different species were recorded.
