Approve Belfountain Change House

The Credit Valley Conservation Authority has received approval from the Ministry of Natural Resources in the amount of \$25,000 for a new washroom-changehouse, a new gatehouse and landscaping at the Belfountain Conservation Area. Designs are now being prepared for Authority approval. Grants have also been ratified by the Ministry for the acquisition of two small parcels of land (Ireland and Hepworth properties) to be added to the Belfountain Conservation Area. The area now contains about 40 acres of scenic playground along the Credit River.
