Pedal Pushers Pass Through En Route to South America

Monday, Bob Tagosky 18, and Rick Rankin 20, of Huntsville passed through Georgetown making their way to South America. With 4,000 miles left to go the only goal they have in mind is to escape the cold of Canada, but even that they have already experienced. They slept in damp box cars before they reached here, and as they pedalled through Gravenhurst, snow had already blanketed the area.

The two set out from North Bay a week ago with a 50 pound knapsack. When they reached here Monday, they had diminished to 30 pounds and they predicted at least another 10 pounds would be shed before Windsor.

LOT OF JUNK
"We were carrying a lot of junk," said Tagosky. "Each time we stopped, we got rid of another T-shirt."

Despite the wet weather, however, the two did not bother to take a tent along. An Ontario ensign is acting as their only protection aside from their sleeping bags.

Two pairs of jeans, a sweater, a Maple Leaf white T-shirt, a raincoat, a jean jacket, several pairs of socks and underwear and all Canadian hockey suspenders make up the major bulk of the rucksacks.

The only food they're carrying is some apple sauce, protein pills, sunflower seeds, and Southern Comfort for damp nights and spirits.

"Bob's a health nut - that's why the bicycetes," said Rankin.

ALWAYS A ROOF
The rest of the food, as with their shelter will have to be found on the way.

"There's always a roof or meal ahead," said Tagosky, philosophically.

When asked why they were taking the trip, aside from getting out of the cold weather, the two said the only alternative was going to Europe.

Tagosky also added: "We didn't want to work", and said he thought this the best way for the two of them to find themselves.

The farewell from their parents was limited to two brief phrases: "You're crazy. Good luck", said Tagosky.

All Three Agree No Death Penalty

All three Halton federal candidates agree that capital punishment should be abolished.

A House of Commons vote on its permanent abolition is expected in the next Parliament.
