Residents Charge Town Breaking Own By-Law

Dear. Sirs: The residents of the Rexway, Chipper Court area want to know how long they are going to have to put up with garbage dumps on town property along the sidewalks and the land nearby. One such dump on Rexway, almost opposite Sargent Road, consists of a huge pile of old paint cans, broken glass, broken concrete, bits of wood, paper, etc., etc., much of which is embedded in a sea of mud close by. Immediately beside the sidewalk is a small shed surrounded by garbage, and against which are leaning, rusty window panes with broken glass. Now, should any unfortunate child slip or be pushed on to this he could be cut to pieces and possibly blinded by the lagged, broken glass.

All this on town property, and has been for months! The whole area is a filthy mess. And yet when the town foreman, who happened to be in a truck near this dump one day, was approached, he said there was nothing he could do, it wasn't theirs.

This was also reported to the Town Inspector who, even when in the area, neglected to look at it. The Town Engineer absolved himself of all responsibility by declaring that the town was in a dirty state because the citizens had no civic pride.

As long as the Town allows these dumps right in the middle of residential areas. it certainly deals a very effective "death blow" to civic pride. In fact, before this area was devastated, one resident used to keep an empty lot beside his house, clear of any dirt or garbage and even mow the grass, to make the corner of Sargent and Rexway look neat and pleasant, but what's the use now? The pertinent question is who is without civic pride, the citizens or the Town?

We, the residents want to know how much longer we have to tolerate this deplorable situation? And when are the roads, torn up nine months ago by the construction company going to be fixed?

And most important, after it is evenually cleared up, what steps are council going to take to prevent this happening every time construction occurs in residential areas? This is the fourth time in this area in three years.

It would seem that the only effective way must be an arrangement with the construction company before it moves in, that the lots must be cleaned of all debris and garbage on and around the lots each night before

There are still quite a few lots round here and many all over Georgetown and if the Town continues its lax control, Heaven help us all. One wonders what happened to that new by-law

passed on 8th August.






