

First Aid Trainees Come From All Walks of Life

Twenty-five Georgetown and area residents registered last Tuesday evening for the St. John First Aid Training course. Standard First Aid Training Manuals were handed to the new recruits as they arrived at the Georgetown Volunteer Ambulance Service Station, by Tom Massena G.V.A.S. chief and John Potter a provincial staff officer with the corps.

Tom Massena is teaching the eight week course, which will be followed by an exam consisting of multiple choice questionnaire and a practical

problem. John Potter will be the examiner. The graduates receive a St. John Ambulance First Aid Certificate, which is recognized with the Workmen's Compensation Board.

This is a provincial program which had 52,000 enrolled last year. The cost of tuition is \$11 per person, but in Georgetown the ambulance corps is covering the cost. The tuition for most candidates from industry, who can supply the instructor with the Workmen's Compensation Board number of

their firm, will be paid by the Board.

PRACTICAL APPLICATION

Seventy-five percent of the course will be taught by practical application, one of the students playing the victim. Films and slides secured from the provincial office in Toronto will be shown. The subjects covered are: control of hemorrhaging; proper treatment of fractures; artificial respiration (both mouth to mouth, and revised Silvester the mechanized method); treatment of unconscious

casualties; minor poisonings and injuries.

The people taking the course from this area come from all walks of life. To list a few from Tuesday's registration: a printer, horse-riding instructor, draftsman, school teacher, tobacco worker, paper mill employee, a man from factory set up, town employees, truck driver, and a construction superintendent.

The First Aid course began this past Tuesday evening at the ambulance hall.

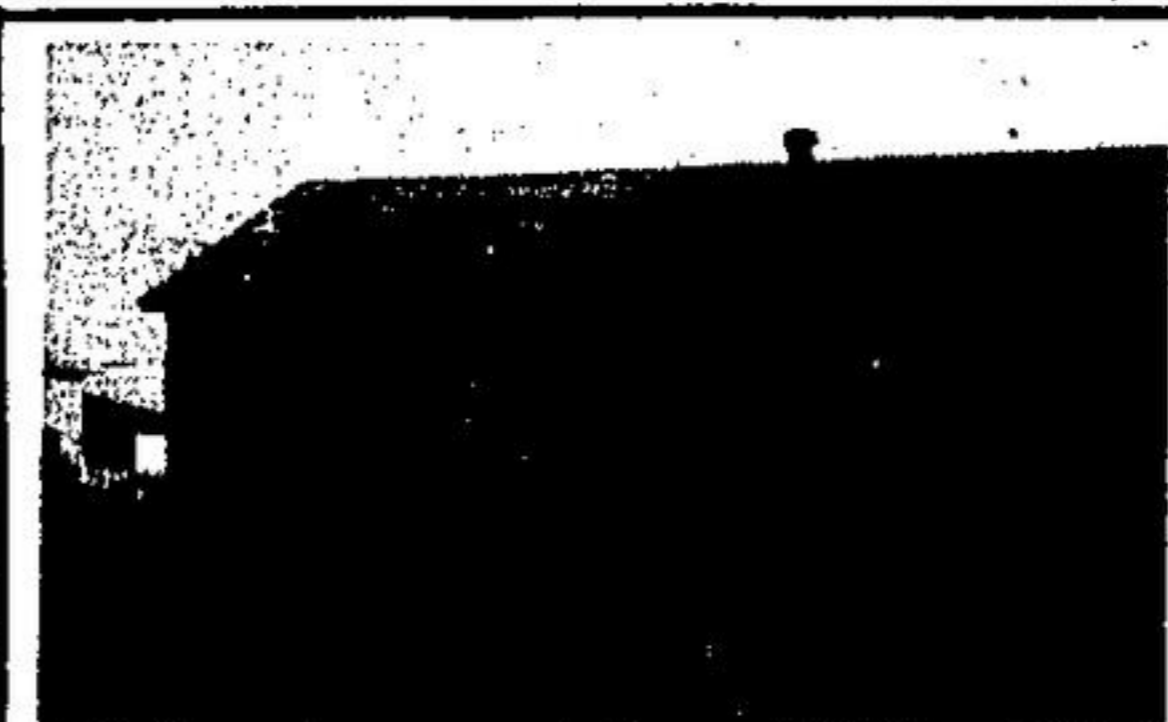
