Former Treasurer Explains The Railway Bonus Fund

11 Emery St. Sir: In your issue of Jan. 10th, 1973, there was a short column reporting that the Esquesing Township Council was disestablishing the Railway Bonus Fund and transferring the money therein to other uses, and giving a short explanation as to where the Railway Bonus Fund came from.

The company originally planned a building of eight storeys and a penthouse with 81 units, but because of conflict with residents in the area, the plan was modified.

The permit was issued in 1968 by a court order, writ of Mandamus after some conflict with the town. Construction has been delayed, the foundation being laid at an early date, but continuous work on the site not starting until last October.
