Mrs. F. Baines Heads PCs Georgetown, Esquering

Mrs. Fran Baines was elected president of Georgetown and Esquering Progressive Conservative Association last week.

Mrs. Baines succeeds John T. Armstrong, who chaired the annual meeting in St. Alban's parish hall, Glen Williams. Wednesday night in the election, conducted by Hon. James W. Snow, M.P., Merle Reid was chosen vice president; Pamela Stopper, secretary; Graeme Goebelle, treasurer; and Wendy Duykes and Glenn Magnuson, directors. These are two new offices added to the association.

Mr. Snow spoke about the past year as a busy one for Halton P.C.s and for himself. He outlined his own areas of responsibility in the Ontario Cabinet, pointing out such projects, completed or underway, as GO transit, regional government, Bronte Creek provincial park, transfer of Ontario Barracks, Oakville, into a retarded care centre; new citizens apartments in Georgetown, Milton and Oakville; and a new LCBO store in Georgetown.

Asked about implementation date for regional government, his opinion is January 1, 1974, with elections this October.

Terry O'Connor, who was elected federal Halton M.P. last year, advised that a move has been initiated by Liberal backbenchers and others, to keep federal ridings as they are, at least until after the next federal election. Halton riding was one of the major changes proposed recently.

He had attended hearings held by the Commission in Toronto that week, and said there is sympathy in retaining the name Halton in the riding, and in making boundaries the same as in the province, keeping Georgetown in Halton riding.

Asked his opinion on capital punishment, he favours abolition of the death sentence, with a minimum 25 year sentence for murder, and tightening of bail and parole laws.

Gasoline Price War

The Georgetown gas war has called a truce at 49.9 cents, but the banners of the different legions still don the horizon. These large plaquards which sit on the perimeters of the various stations read in large bold lettering 49.9 cents and are a constant reminder that peace takes time.

The gas molecule is as unstable as its dealers when it comes to prices. The area between Toronto and Whitby on Highways 7 and 12 has prices between 40.9 and 42.9. The 115 and 35 Highways heading north to Peterborough and Lindsay have settled their war at 43.9.

Private dealers in Georgetown are still waving the red flag at 46.9 cents, and the company dealers taking a loss under the relatively new price conditions.

\$8,150 Fire Damage in Ten Alarms

Estimated damage to property as a result of fire for the month of January was \$8,150, January 1972 had nil.

Georgetown volunteer firefighters answered 10 calls last month, which was two more than January 1972. Seven of the calls were in Georgetown and three in Esquering. Last year five were in Georgetown and three in Esquering.

Six of the calls were to buildings and four others. Six were caused by negligence and two listed as other, with two maintenance calls being this year's total to date.
