If any one of these conditions exist in your home, call in the expert, and don't be surprised if he tells you that a complete home wiring modernization job is required. 

provision of electrical outlets. The outlets must not be more than twelve feet apart and no point along the floorline should be more than six feet from an outlet in any room of the house


A new way to really get your mail moving: Postal Codes.

If you haven't already received it, in the next few days you'll be getting your new Postal Code in the mail. It's not very exciting to look at. But it is very necessary. And it's really not as complicated as it looks.

After two years of studying the systems of most of the countries of the world, here's how we developed Postal Codes for Canada.

The map sequence on the right shows just how accurate Postal Codes really are.

To uncomplicate your Postal Code, you will be receiving a Postal Code Pack age. It contains your code, instructions on how to use it, a handy address book, special Postal Code stickers for




And if you haven't received your Code by March 12th, please call your local Post Office. We will mail it to you immediately. It is possible however, that you are not in the CENTRAL ONTARIO POSTAL DISTRICT, in which case your area may not have been coded yet.
