slide brought down a pine tree between two houses and about 40 tons of mud.

The team explored about 47 slopes and small stretches surrounding slopes along this 29-mile stretch of the river. They measured slope angles, or if the slope was made up of more than one material, the slope angle of each material.

After this, several mathematical variables were drawn up and team could come up with a rim valley line, situated a distance away from the top of the slope.

Any construction beyond this line, according to the experts, is safe.

**35 SLOPES**  
In the 25 hazardous slopes discovered by the team, they found over 100 houses.

Moreover, the team also studied the various zonings in the hazardous slope areas and found the following facts: Port Credit had the hazard area zoned institutional, open space, and residential; Mississauga as green belt with structures permitted open space, industrial, agricultural and residential; Streetsville as flood zone and open space; Chinguacousy as agricultural which meant single family dwellings could be permitted; while official plan of Esquesing permits a hamlet design for Norval and Glen Williams.

**SAFEGUARDS**  
The only municipality that safeguards these areas was that of Georgetown, which presently has a stringent bylaw under consideration.

The Georgetown bylaw is called the environmental open space 0-4 which marks out and controls hazard slopes and flood land and also says that these lands cannot be rezoned without strict remedial measures.

The categories like open space and green belt can be rezoned by the municipality at a later date.

**MORE PRECISE**  
The team would like to see that their findings are incorporated in municipal bylaws.

so that construction on such areas could be controlled. It will be finalizing its report and placing it in the libraries of Erindale College and of the main one of the University of Toronto.

It is also recommending that more precise and detailed analysis should be carried out of not only the 29 miles they studied but also the remaining part of the Credit Valley Conservation Authority.

The discussion, attended by several engineers from Peel municipalities and planners including the county engineer, agreed that the study and its recommendations would be opposed by developers.
