

Partnership Buys Out DeBoer Moving, Storage

DeBoer Movers and Storage, 124 Armstrong Avenue, was sold last month under a management agreement to two partners continuing to represent North American Van Lines.

Hank DeBoer started the business 12 years ago as a local cartage business. He then joined Mayflower Movers and in May, 1970 became a local branch of North American Van

Lines. Mr. DeBoer moved to this 10,000 square foot warehouse on Armstrong Avenue four years ago just prior to joining North American.

Hank DeBoer is now in British Columbia, investigating new enterprises for himself and family. The new partners on Armstrong Avenue are Dean Soucie and Herman Mulvina, who are now in the process of

waiting their operating authority licenses which has to be approved by the Provincial Department of Transportation.

SOUICIE
Dean Soucie after leaving the navy became an apprentice operator for the CNR where he spent one year. He joined North American Van Lines in 1968 where he served out of head office in Pickering as an assistant chief, then chief despatcher, then as traffic manager responsible for all domestic moving in Canada, as well as Canada to the U.S.

He is 26 years of age and knows most of the branch managers across Canada as well as the drivers from his experience at head office. Mr. Soucie is interested in becoming an active member of the community, having approached the Jaycees for membership.

MULVINA
Herman Mulvina, now in his early 40's, has worked his way up through the firm as a packer, warehouseman, long distance trucker from coast to coast, being an owner operator of his tractor-trailer. He is also classified as one of the top 10 drivers in Canada, through a rating in North American Van Lines' quality control program.

North American Van Lines, Georgetown has two tractor-trailers and one straight van. It employs three full time workers and 20 part time employees.

HOPE TO DOUBLE
Dean Soucie says that he hopes to double the business this year and that they are already turning down customers because of lack of facilities, this month. He explained that this expansion would mean an increase in full time and part time help during the summer.

The warehouse is specially equipped for storing furniture, being palletized and vacuumed once a month. Dean also pointed out that North American was the largest van lines in the world and within the top three in Canada.
