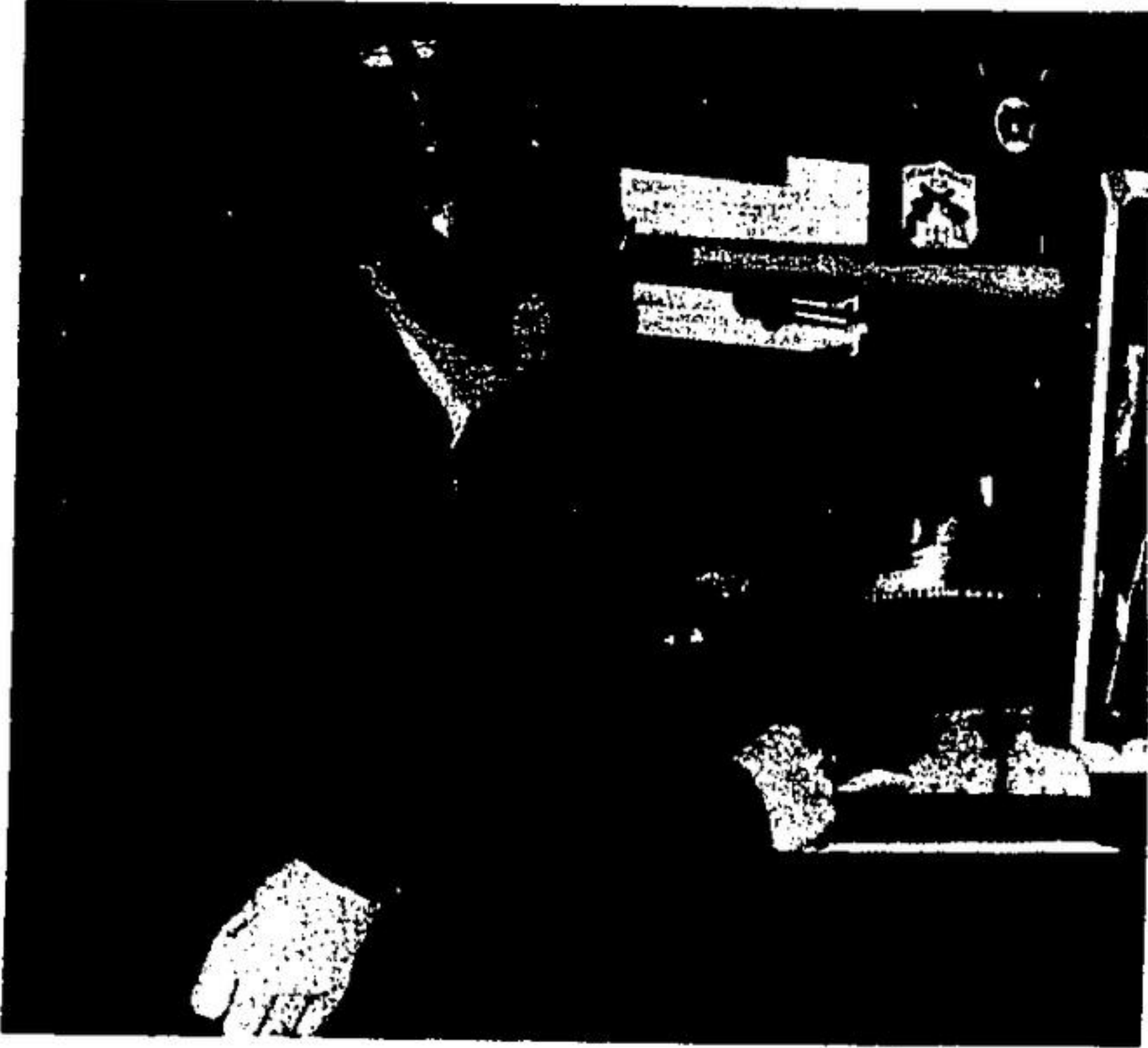


## Brigadier Wallace Headed Racing Body Seven Years

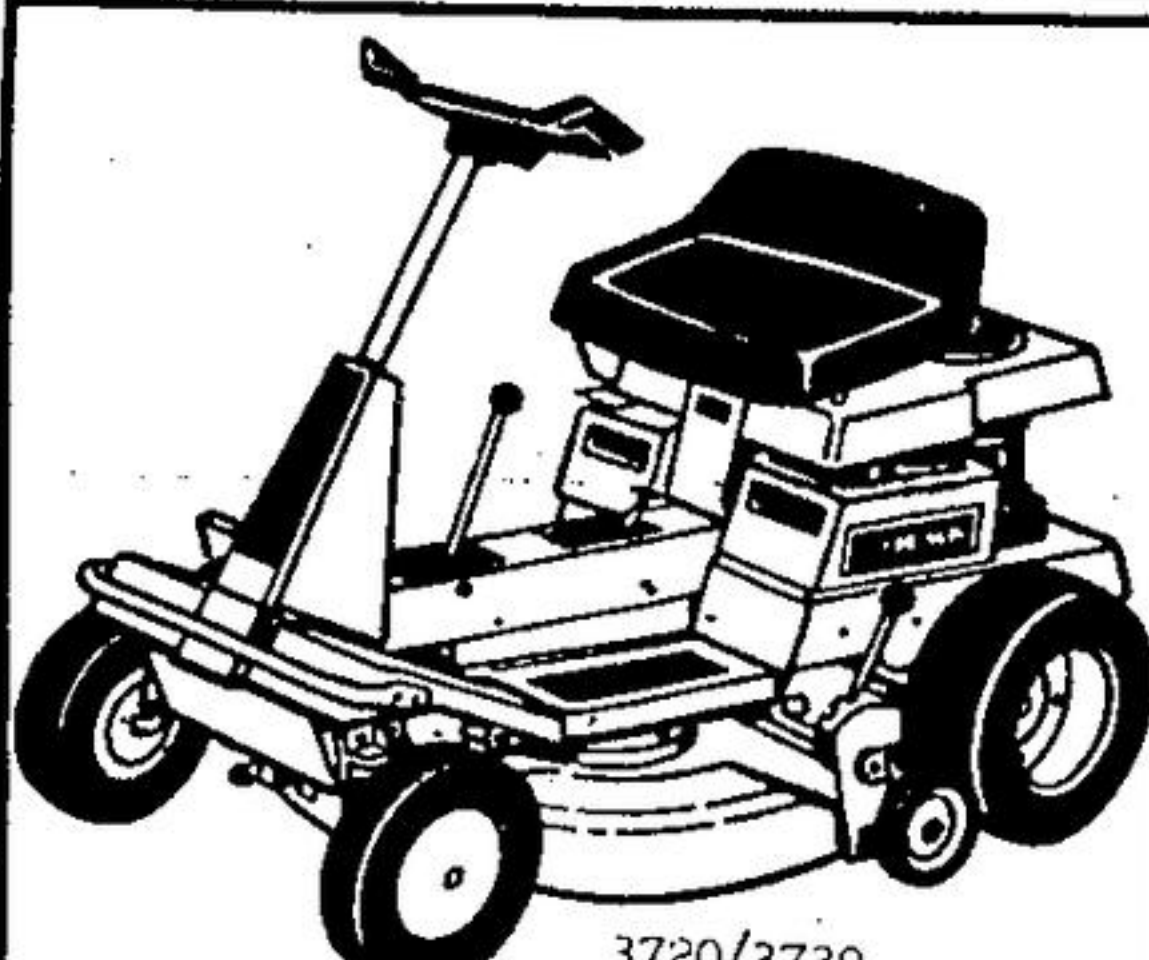
