550 Guests At Opening New Fong's

Approximately 450 people arrived at Fong's spacious new restaurant at 102 Mountainview South on Saturday, April 28 to celebrate the grand opening. Sunday, approximately 100 friends and relatives of Betty and Hank Fong came to wish them double luck and a long life.

Double luck and long life are traditional Chinese expressions and can be found in the decorum that floods the three rooms of the restaurant. The first is a general purpose eating space with 13 tables and red leather arm chairs. The paintings on the walls are Chinese and express feelings of long life. Pictures of a similar nature can be found on the frosted glass in the chandeliers.

The customer enters the dining room through a key hole shaped archway, and on looking to the right, finds a large golden Chinese symbol on the wall. Its meaning is double luck.

The patterned carpet has the basic colour red, and the wall is lined with woven pictures of ancient Chinese instruments. There is a large wood colored bar in the dining room and Fong's are now waiting for their liquor license.

The banquet hall is downstairs and has several six foot tables. Two of the paintings on the walls hung in Fong's restaurant on Main Street, of which Hank Fong was the proprietor for 10 years. The clock in this room has Chinese numbers.

The Fongs came to Georgetown in 1963 from Tweed where they owned two restaurants during their stay.

Hank came to Canada in 1954 from south China. Betty followed in 1957 and they were married in Tweed. They have four children: Peter, Anne, Jeanie and Connie.

SEVEN COOKS
The restaurant cost approximately \$250,000 of which \$80,000 was spent in decorations. Twenty people are employed by the Fongs, including seven cooks. Hank says he will serve 70 different kinds

of meals, in his previous restaurant he served 12 kinds. The one problem that concerns a number of people today is parking. Fong's restaurant has more than adequate parking facilities. The restaurant will seat 200 people.

Erratic Riding Brings Cyclists Police Warning

Concern in the police department over unsafe bicycle riding, has resulted in a warning system to alert parents to some of the practices seen frequently among riders. Chief Police Floyd Schwantz points out the police department

are hesitant to charge children under the Highway Traffic Act, but warns they may be forced into the action to prevent accidents. The warning system consists of a sheet listing various offences, which will be checked, and handed to the bicyclist specifying exactly what they were doing wrong. On the back of the sheet a bicycle safety check list is printed so the parents can look over the bicycles to see if any part is defective. Among the safety violations are, disobeying stop signs, failing to signal, failing to yield, riding without lights, riding double, improper turns, riding on the wrong side of the road, lack of bell, brakes, fenders, etc., and riding no hands.

In "Brush With a Body" there are no fewer than 11 cast members, and 35 members of the production staff whose work is done off stage and therefore largely anonymously. All of these are drawn from a group which this year numbers only 60 people.

Harry Haylock has been working with the stage cast for several weeks and with the help of his artists has created a very "British" family, a truly roguish Irish chimney sweep, and an often tense but always hilarious situation involving a stray and certainly unwanted body.

BUDGETARY RESTRAINTS
Meanwhile, Derek Joynes and Isla McConnell have been trying to conciliate between artistic set designers and practical construction crews, to explain to technical wizards that "budgetary restraints" means no more money, that impossible administrative and printing tasks are performed yesterday and not next week, to ensure that the gentle coercion often necessary to generate outside help does not become too ambitious.

As of Saturday April 28, the auditorium of Wrigglesworth school has been echoing to the likes of "where's my hammer?" "who broke my staple remover?" "that's not the way it's supposed to look!" and the signature of the well oiled production machine "coffee break!"
