

## "Darn Dogs" Only Complaint From the Lady Postman

"I wish you would tell people to keep their dogs tied up. I like dogs and have two of my own, but they make it hard to work", says Sheila Willis, the only female mail carrier at the Georgetown Post Office. Sheila, every work day morning, spends one hour sorting mail then starts out on her 6,000 yard journey, delivering mail on Mountview and Maple Avenue. She says that she has received

comments from women residents who would like a job like hers but couldn't cope with the dogs. October 2, 1972 Sheila joined the post office part time. January 1, 1973, she became a full time employee. There are 94 calls on her route which is a part-time route, but she also covers for mailmen who are sick, etc. and can't make it into work.

The 37 year old plays left full back for the Toronto Carriers field hockey team who won the Ontario League Championship this year and the Oakville Cup last year. She received her bronze in swimming in school where she also did some competitive diving. In tennis she won the Butlin Cup in England, 1957. The cup is named after a Canadian, William Butlin.

## New Plans Make Possible Fountain Project this Year

Friends of the Museum, Halton County, held their annual meeting Thursday, May 3 at the County Administration Building, Steeles Avenue, Milton. The meeting was chaired by the newly-elected president, John McDonald, Georgetown.

The financial report was presented by the auxiliary's auditor, Graeme Goebelle. The fund-raising programme of the Friends enabled them to present \$1000 to the museum last year. This gift was for the completion of the log cabin and the building of a terrace in front of the barn this spring.

The most financially successful project was the Christmas time raffie of the antique brass candlestick, followed by the "white elephant" table, quilt draw at the Summer Festival at Kelso Park, and the sale of chocolate bars throughout the year. Cash on hand at April 30, 1973 - \$443.70.

Museum director, Dr. H. J. Newman, presented new engineering plans for the terrace fountain - the Friends' project for 1973. With these new plans, the fountain can be constructed along with the terrace this spring, rather than in 1974 as had been previously planned.

With the annual festival only four months away, the president made the following appointments: R. Harris, Milton - poster printing; Mrs. I. Saunders, Hornby - tea tables; Mrs. J. Goebelle, Georgetown - entertainment; Mrs. R. Trace, Nassagaweya - "white elephant" table; Mrs. Saunders and Mr. Tracy - radio and newspaper publicity; G. Goebelle - refreshments. The Festival will be held at the museum Sept. 8 and 9.
