At the request of the Council of the Town of Georgetown, the Ministry of the Environment has investigated the possibility of installing within the said Town a sewage works project and now proposes to construct such works at an estimated cost of \$1,100,000, and to make application to the Ontario Municipal Board for approval of the undertaking and im posing of a special sewage works rate. It is proposed to borrow the amount of \$733,333 from the Central Mortgage and Housing Corporation to be repaid over a period of twenty years, and the balance of \$366,667 will be repaid to the Ministry of the Environment over the same period.

The proposed project would consist of sewage works to be constructed as follows:

Extension of the existing activated sludge sewage treatment plant to increase its rated capacity from 1.5 to 3.0 MIGD, and the addition of effluent polishing facilities com prising automatic back wash lilters, including all equipment and ap purtenances.

After allowing for the Central Mortgage and Housing Corporation's write off in the amount of \$183,333, the estimated annual cost of the project, which includes debt retirement, interest, Central Mortgage & Housing Cor poration's payment, reserve for contingencies and operating costs, is \$124,087. It is proposed to raise this sum by imposing a 50 percent surcharge on the annual water bill of all users of the sewage works system.

A typical home with a water bill of \$60.00 per annum will pay \$30.00 per annum for the sewage works project.

Any ratepayer may within 21 days after the first publication of this notice, send by prepaid post to the clerk of the Town of Georgetown, at the address given below, a notice in writing approval or the imposition of the special rate.

The Ontario Municipal Board may approve the special rate pursuant to the statute and the community, first through but before doing so, it may appoint a time and a place for a public nearing when any ob jections will be considered, but given only to those persons who have given notice of such ob jection as provided for above.
