A three man delegation which attended a recent Georgetown Public Library Board meeting to put forward proposals on the group's behalf reported to the members.

The proposals urged adequate washroom facilities for people confined to wheelchairs in the library extension among other modifications.

A film followed the business meeting.

Something new will be added to the Red Cross Water Safety Week next month. For the last few weeks eight water safety bugs have been knocking their heads together preparing for Water Safety Week, June 3-9.

Last year, Ontario's drowning rate increased 20 percent and they feel that something should be done about it.

Since backyard pools are becoming increasingly popular in Georgetown, the chance of accidents in and around the pool area is becoming more common. Many people say that

it could never happen in their pool because they think they have enough knowledge of preventing water accidents. But if it did happen would they really know what to do?

"To help provide the information, we are putting on three demonstrations in Georgetown backyard pools", Mrs. Lynda Clipham of the Georgetown Red Cross Branch told The Herald.

"Included in our demonstrations will be reaching assists, how to use them, when to use them and care of them, and artificial respiration with

different situations needed". There will also be a brief instruction on pool maintenance. The last part is general water safety.

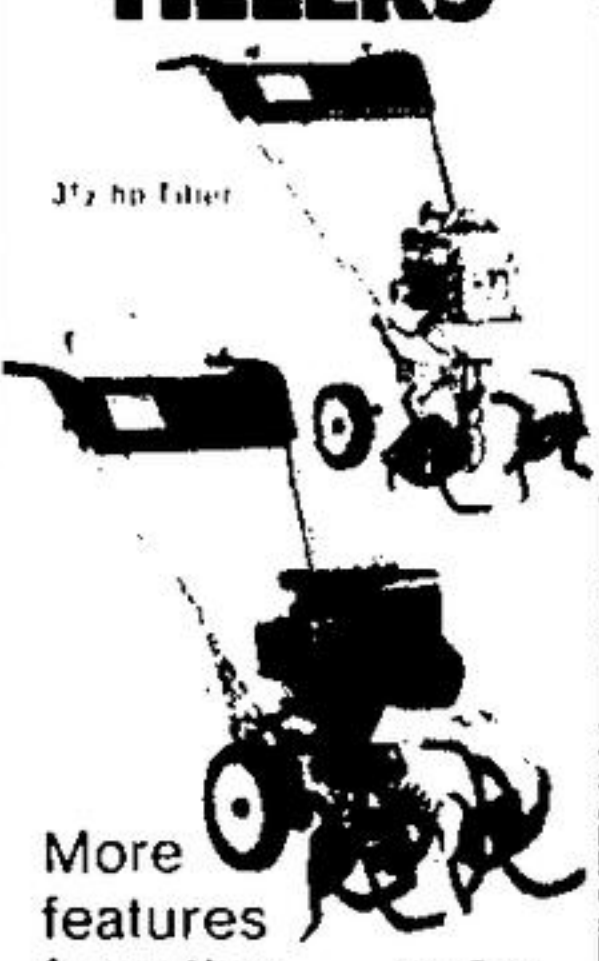

Burlington Trustee Tony Goodyear questioned the need for nine assistant superintendents and said he was going to look further into the question.

This came about when the Halton Board of Education passed the appointment of Wayne F. Burns and Nick P. Volpe to positions of assistant superintendents, last Thursday.

Board Secretary Tom Watson said they interviewed nine candidates for the positions.

Wayne Burns has a B.A. from the University of Western Ontario, a Specialist in Physical and Health Education and holds a Secondary School Principal's Certificate.

His teaching career began at Forest Hill Collegiate in Toronto. He came to Nelson High School at its opening in 1957, spent six years as Head of Boys' Physical and Health Education and five years as Assistant Principal. He was an Assistant Principal at Burlington Central High School for one year and in 1969 became principal of Lord Elgin High School, a position which he has filled with distinction.

As principal at Lord Elgin, Mr. Burns has been the leader in an educational organization which has become known across Ontario and beyond. In addition to making worthwhile changes in secondary school organization and practice, he has been able to foster an effective liaison with the elementary schools and principals in his area. As well as joint program development projects, the liaison includes exchanges of teachers and administrators for varying periods of time.

Mr. Burns is married and has three children.

Nick Volpe holds a B.P.H.E. from the University of Toronto and, in addition, a B.Ed. and an M.Ed. He is a Specialist in Physical and Health Education and a Specialist in Guidance.

His teaching career began in Port Credit High School where he became Head of Physical and Health Education. He was a teacher and instructor at the University of Toronto schools and the College of Education as Co-ordinator of Physical and Health Education in 1967. At the formation of the Halton County Board of Education, Mr. Volpe assumed the same role with the county.

Mr. Volpe has been associated with many organizations and committees in the county and beyond. In addition to his interests in physical education, he was a member of the Ad Hoc Committee on Priorities and Expenditures.

Mr. Volpe has worked in Physical and Health Education on a K-13 basis and, through his co-ordination, core programs are published. His present association with the Primary Task Force will complete the K-13 spectrum.
