

Esquusing Council Briefs

At Esquusing Council meeting, Monday night:

The week beginning June 17, was declared Senior Citizens week in the Township of Esquusing.

A building permit was approved to Umberto Giangrande on the east half of Lot 5, Concession 2, for a restaurant and a four bedroom apartment subject to Mr. Giangrande receiving the necessary approvals from the Halton County Health Unit and the Township of Esquusing Building Inspector.

A building permit to Randall Banish was extended for an additional 12 months subject to the building inspector's approval. The permit was received September 28, 1972, but the time elapsed before Mr. Banish could build his garage.

The clerk was instructed to forward copies of by-law 17-73 to a list of owners, supplied by the township solicitor, of lots in the old registered plans of subdivision for purposes of subsection 2 of section 29 of the Planning Act. A letter will be included notifying that by-law 17-73 was passed April 16, 1973 and that it is to prevent further division of their land in any way without the consent of the committee of adjustment.

In correspondence, a letter was received from Limehouse Minor Sports asking for a township grant to help finances of four minor baseball teams. They have 72 players, 18 to a team.

The clerk of Esquusing will meet with the clerk of Nassagaweya Township to discuss a council considered staff report in respect to the disposal of garbage picked up in adjacent municipalities and disposed of in another.

A letter from Mr. D. Donaldson stated that the 3rd Line road at Lot 13 in the township was unsafe in the elevated portion, that the rough, unfinished road surface, and damage to his property were unrepaired. Council stated that the road superintendent was aware of it and as soon as the weather permitted would get it.

Council told Mr. Viggo Mosekjaer that he could build his 150-112 foot greenhouse on Lot 3, Concession 6, east of the 5th Line. He will be wholesaling his own flowers so there is no change in the land use.

Word was received that the Ministry of Transportation and Communication had approved by-law 9-73; a speed limit on the 6th Line at 35 miles per hour.

Council refused to join the Roads and Transportation Association of Canada whose requested membership fee is \$75.

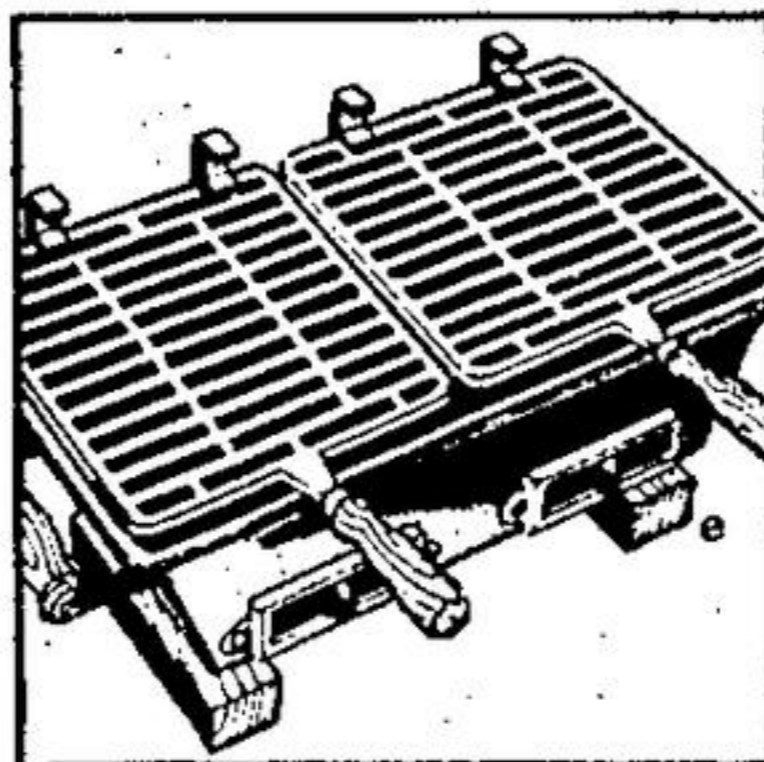

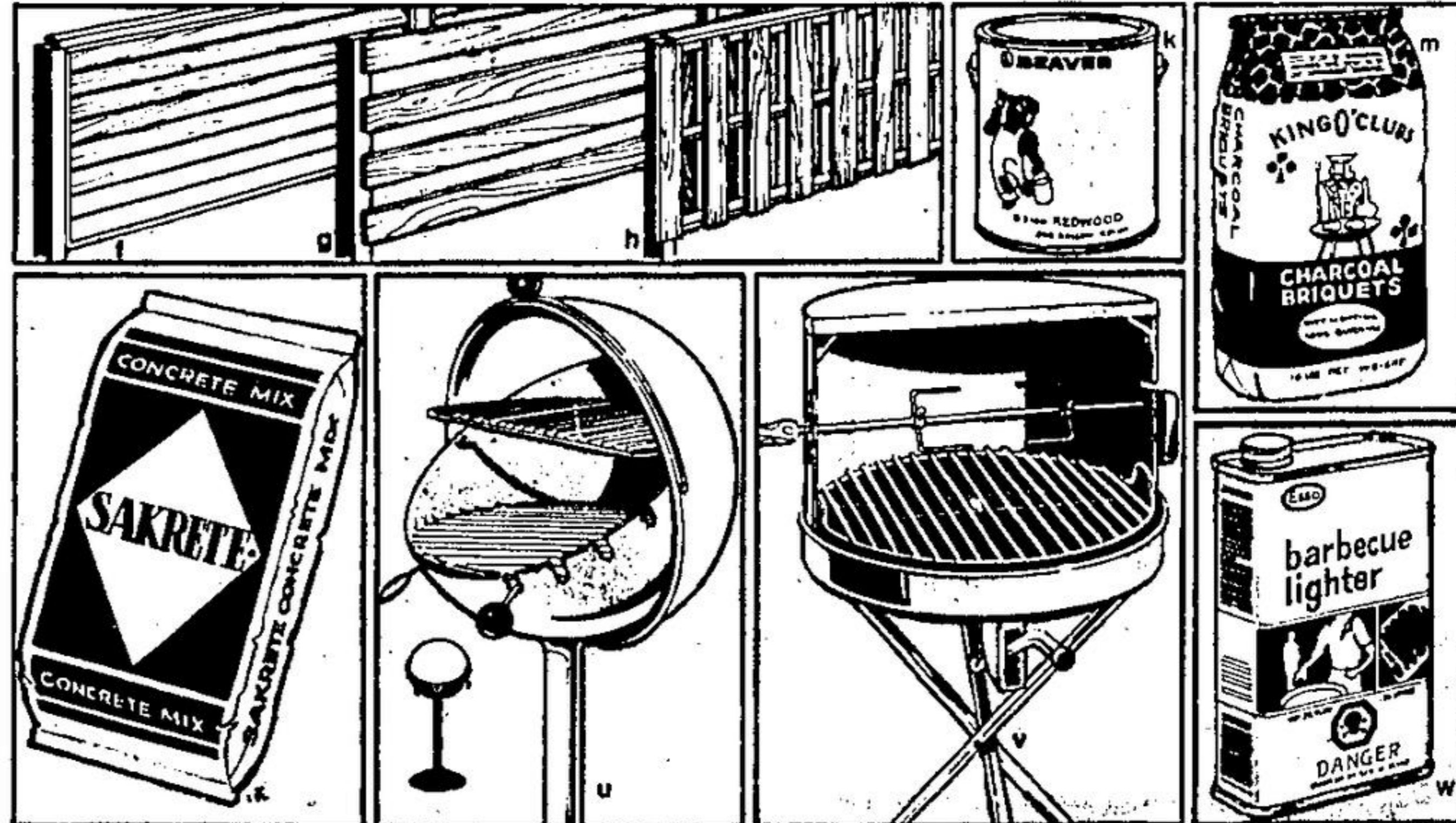
