

4-H Programs in Canada Mark 60th Anniversary

TORONTO—The 4-H program in Canada marks its sixtieth anniversary this year. Many special events are planned for the highlight being a national conference at which delegates will take an in-depth look at the 4-H program, according to the current Commercial Letter of Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce.

4-H (in Quebec, Cercles de Jeunes Ruraux) is a nationwide educational program the primary goal of which is to

Take A Look At Spending

Bud Snow, road superintendent for Esqueving Township, told council Tuesday that more than \$220,000 has been spent by the roads department so far this year. Council had asked for the figures and breakdown of the roads department accounts, so that it could see how much of the roads budget was spent in maintenance and construction.

Esqueving council has passed a bylaw from county council which is designed to prevent the destruction of trees in the area by restricting and regulating the cutting and burning of trees.

Losses of livestock to three Esqueving farmers by dogs annoying their cattle will be made good by Esqueving township. Council agreed to pay

\$70 to W. James Russell for one calf injured and aborted June 24; \$210 to Robert Russell for two calves killed by dogs June 1 and one calf born dead due to the cow being chased; and \$16 to Spencer Wilson for two trips.

Council approved payment of road accounts of the amount of \$42,825.30.

Esqueving council again is unable to buy a truck for its roads department. The council resolved not to act on tenders because of insufficient funds in subsidy from the provincial government. Two tenders were received of which only one was a firm 1974 price. This is the second time tenders have come to council for the truck. Insufficient bids were received the first time and it was decided to invite tenders again.

in the United States in the early 1900s. The first Canadian boys' and girls' club - which was to be the predecessor of the 4-H clubs in Canada - was established at Roland, Manitoba, in 1913. By 1972, the 4-H program in Canada had grown to more than 5,900 clubs with 78,000 members.

POSITIVE ATTITUDE

"The 4-H program strives to help members acquire a positive attitude toward learning by increasing their knowledge and developing their skills in subjects of interest and value. Other aims are the development of leadership qualities, decision-making abilities, and a sense of responsibility. The member also learns to work effectively with others through group activities," says the Commercial Letter.

Each 4-H member must conduct at least one project during the club year. Most clubs are organized on the basis that all members will carry out the same type of project. In communities where there aren't enough potential members interested in the same project, a club may be formed in which the members can choose from among several different projects.

Achievement awards include scholarships, certificates, scholarships and trips. In most provinces outstanding members meet regularly at regional and provincial conferences and seminars to discuss issues important to them and to their future role in society.

INNOVATION

"A recent innovation is the junior or youth leadership program which offers senior 4-Hers an opportunity to develop skills and abilities through the practice of leadership under the guidance of an adult leader. One of the aims of this program is to equip these young leaders to assist their adult counterparts in helping a 4-H club and its members achieve their objectives. "The Commercial Letter states.

The provision of staff and other services in support of 4-H club activity provincially

represents a substantial financial commitment by all provincial governments. The federal Department of Agriculture also contributes extensively through the participation of its specialists and by financing a portion of 4-H grants, travel assistance for members and club leaders, and certain educational materials. Many business, agricultural and service organizations

contribute prize money or awards to local clubs. The desirability of a national program across Canada, it is perhaps best known to the club member as the co-ordinator of national and international programs. To expand its financial base the Council of 4-H Clubs whose established non-profit function is to facilitate the development of the 4-H 1969.


