

# Jim Zakia Romps To Win In Modified Eliminator

 For the second straight week, Jim Zakia's consistent sub-10-second times proved too much for the modified eliminator Dragway as he easily romped home to first place and the \$250 purse.

Zakia's 9.24 clocking in the first-round pairing disposed of Don Neeland's B-MP Camaro, while the C-G Cuda of the Smith Brothers continued to have difficulty getting back on track as Frank Elliott trailed the gaser with a 10.52-132 effort. Rudy Held's Opel defeated Paul Campbell's E-MP Fairlane with an off-pace 10.25, while in other action Brian Little's C-A Cuda encountered all kinds of handling problems forcing Brian to ease off the throttle letting John Rossiter's Camaro go on for an easy win. In their first appearance at TID the Ball Auction's C-G Camaro cut a red light sending the Guelph based car packing as Don Cloake went on for the win 10.74-140 mph. The Vani C-A Vega advanced to another round with the bye run.

The Zakia Opel continued to turn out times right on the A-G National Record and in second round blasted by the Parkdale Vega with 9.24-150 mph. Elliott survived round two by upsetting Held's Gold Gambler on a 10.47-134 pass and John Rossiter closed out the second round winners with a fine 11.05 clocking in defeating Cloake's Cuda.

Frank Elliott drew the bye in third round while Rossiter and Zakia squared off. At the traps it was the A-G Opel on top against 9.29-148 to the trailing Camaro. Rossiter's finish however was

good enough to collect third place money.

To determine fourth place, money winner Held's Gambler Opel, Vani Brothers Vega and Don Cloake's C-A Cuda drew for pairings, with the latter getting automatic bye. The Vega hung on for the win over the Opel, 11.16-125 mph but in the final pairing came out on the short end as Cloake laid down a powerful 10.01-141 m.p.h. split to Vani's trailing 11.04.

In a repeat of last week's final, Joe Zakia blew by Frank Elliott with a strong top end charge, recording 9.24-148 m.p.h. to the B-MP respectable 10.40-130 mph.

Super stocks were out in full force again and after round one of eliminations survivors were: Eric Kramp's SS-L Camaro, Pete Fedun's SS-K, Gino Reardon's Chevle, Saund's SS-1 "Gypsy Sinner", Phil Gionet's SS-E Nova, Neil Smedley's SS-KA Dodge, Tony Luminoso's SS-DA Camaro and Plymouth's pair with Chuck Dall and Norm Dutton.

Second round action is probably one a few drivers would just as soon forget. By virtue of four consecutive red lights, Dall, Reade, Smedley and Gionet were all eliminated, leaving easy wins to their respective opponents, Saund's Sinner, Pete Fedun, Eric Kramp and Tony Luminoso. Norm Dutton drew the bye run and a birth in next round.

In the first pairing of the third round Luminoso's SS-DA Camaro ended Norm Dutton's night with an 11.70-117 mph pass. After correcting a mistake in the handicap start Pete Fedun and the Gypsy Sinner re-

## THE DISTRICT AT A GLANCE

**MISSISSAUGA**—A proposed stacked townhouse development that would result in a population of up to 2,000 persons should be reduced by half to preserve the quality of life in the neighborhood, the Applewood Heights Homeowners' Association has told council. A petition signed by 800 persons (representing all homeowners) in Applewood Heights, said the development would result "in substantial dislocations in the area of education, traffic, parking and recreation."

**ACTON**—Council has accepted the tender of Warren Bitulithic for the resurfacing of town streets in the amount of \$139,431. The bid was the lowest of six submitted. Other bids included Armstrong Brothers of Brampton, \$146,485; Capital Paving of Guelph, \$154,138; Pave-A-J of Milton, \$156,785; Graham Brothers of Brampton, \$168,274; and Fernar Paving of Burlington, \$190,594. Public works committee chairman, Earl Masales said approximately 90 percent of the town's streets will be included in the program. Some will receive major treatment, others minor, he said.

**ORANGEVILLE**—Orangeville has been selected as an area for further development of the Summer School of the Arts and Georgian College. A combined course, Life Drawing and Landscape Drawing, has been arranged in co-operation with the Orangeville Art Group, to provide an outdoor summer art study from Aug. 6 to 17. The art student or novice on this course will have the opportunity for developing his own approach to art from the model as well as from the Hockley Valley countryside background.

**BURLINGTON**—Tom Foster was named a replacement for the late North Burlington councillor Mrs. Ella Foote last Monday. He was sworn in and welcomed by members of council and sat in on his first meeting at Burlington Town Hall. The 41-year-old farmer was runner-up to Mrs. Foote in a three-way race for the Ward Three seat in last December's election. Tom Patience, a teacher from Kilbride, was third in the race. Mrs. Foote died earlier this month after a year-long battle with cancer. Foster will fill her unexpired term until the end of 1973.

**MILTON**—Milton Planning Board will seek a definition of what constitutes a neighborhood shopping centre. The question came under discussion Wednesday when the board discussed a proposal for Cloverlawn Investments. Cloverlawn wants to establish a 14-store complex at the corner of Ontario Street and Steeles Avenue. Members agreed to see if the proposal would constitute a neighborhood shopping centre prior to making a zoning change. It was noted that if the proposal was to be considered a neighborhood shopping centre it wouldn't be desirable.

**BRAMPTON**—Planning board approval of Official Plan amendments permitting application for construction of two housing subdivisions in the northern sector of Brampton will be forwarded to town council. The board's approval of the subdivisions followed a public meeting last Tuesday on the Kerbel Development Ltd. townhouse development north of Alden Street, east of Garfield Crescent, and the Dornpark Developments, east and west of the CPR tracks, north of Rosedale Avenue.

**BRAMALEA**—A two percent growth limitation in Chinguacousy Township north of lot 16 has been backed by Chinguacousy Township planning board after a staff report backing the proposal was submitted. The board will ask township council to approve the limitation growth, which was requested by the Ward 2 citizens' advisory committee. The committee called for the limitation until an official plan has been established for the new Peel region. An official plan is set for 1976.
