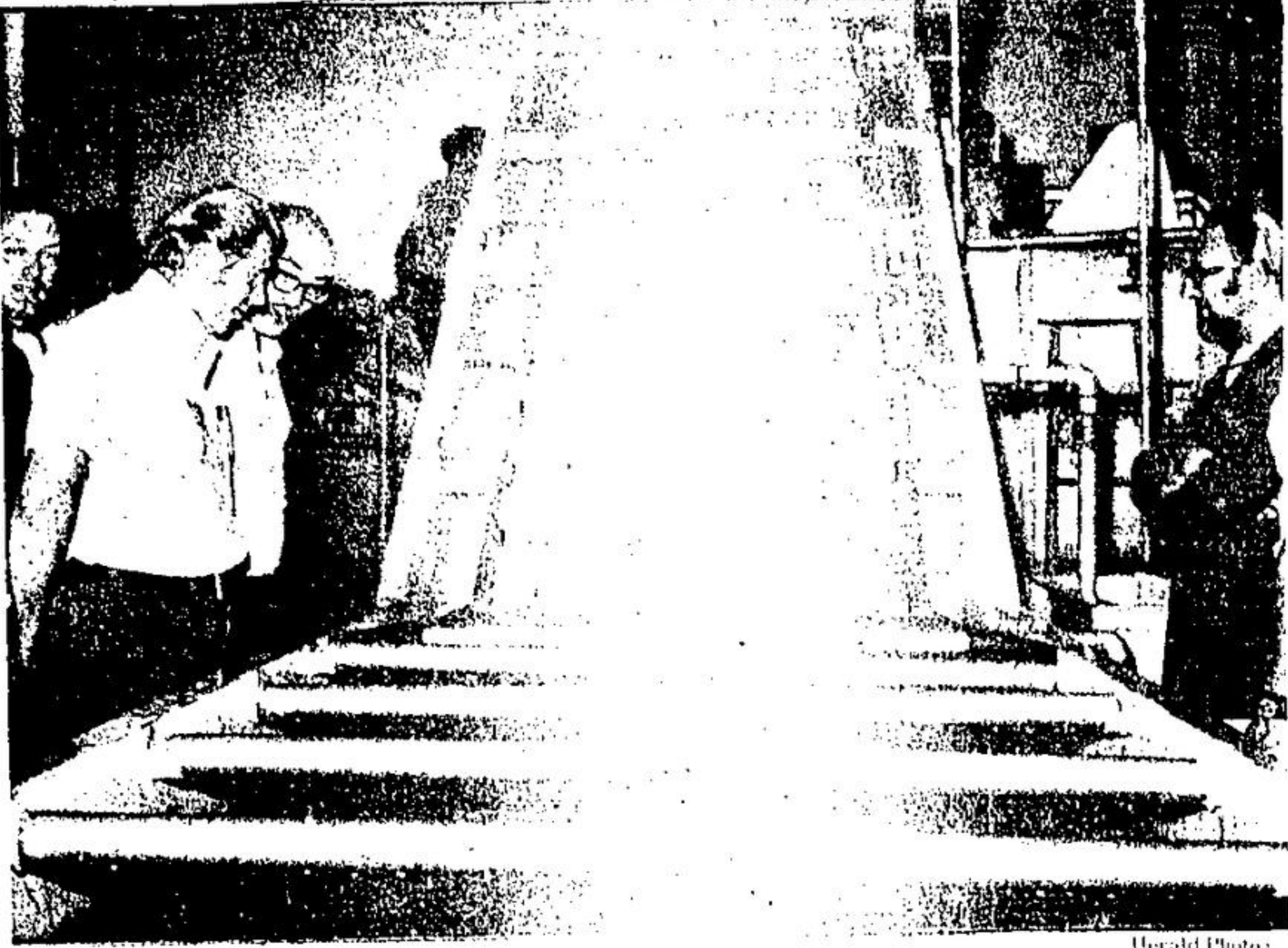


HYDRO TOUR AT MUSHROOM PLANT

Invite Public Debate About Hydro Corridor

Details have been released of alternative routes for the proposed 500 KV hydro corridor connecting generating stations at Nanticoke and Pickering. The routes will now be open to public discussion before a final choice is made.

Selection of these possible alignments comes after six months of intensive study of environmental factors. The study has been carried out under the auspices of the Solandt Commission, which was set up by the government after objections to the route originally proposed by Ontario Hydro last year.

Dr. Solandt recommended that an independent environmental study should be carried out, and Mr. Howlett was commissioned to undertake the task. The alternative routes now presented all have a minimum impact on the environment. One of them must be selected for eventual recommendation to the Solandt Commission.

Of the suggested alternatives, the most southerly alignment would cross the Niagara Escarpment near Milton, and then run south of Brampton and around Toronto International Airport south of Woodbridge. Crossing Yonge Street near Thornhill, this route then connects with the Cherrywood transformer station near Pickering. A more northerly alignment would follow one of several possible routes north from

Frederick, before each party has then set out its Mother station. Yonge Street runs around Hill and this route would be south of Woodbridge.

From east of the route could be southern alternative. Cherrywood is north of the route, an important industrial area, and this alternative would be south of Woodbridge.
