17 Crashes Are Costly

Officers from Milton detach-ment of the Ontario Provincial Police investigated 68 general occurrences during the week of June 17 to 25. Included in this number were two thefts, one break and enter, one disturbance, two complaints of trespass, one assault, one impaired driving charged, eight liquor charges, one threatening complaint, three domestic disputes, one wilful damage and two dangerous driving complaints. The remaining occurrences were minor in nature and required little time to clear.

Seventeen motor vehicle collisions were investigated during the period, involving 25 vehicles. Total property damage was estimated at \$22,653. Eighteen persons were injured in 10 of these collisions and one person was killed. Eleven drivers involved have been summonsed to appear in provincial court at Milton. Causes of these collisions have been attributed to: careless driving, loss of control, following too close and .impaired driving.

several parents were there to greet the exhausted travellers. and to turn a trite phrase -- a good time was had by all.




