Effluent No Longer A Problem

The effluent problem at Abitibi's Georgetown coating mill has been completely resolved according to a pamphiet published by Abitibi Paper Company Ltd.

"The effluent problem at this fine paper converting mill has been completely resolved." says the pamphlet. "The effluent from this mill is pumped into a cyclator which removes all suspended solid matter that settles out into a sludge form.

"The sludge is then trucked away to a company-owned land dump: The remaining liquid effluent requires a secondary treatment to lower the BOD content to an acceptable level. This is treated in the municipal sewage system. For this service the company pays an annual fee to the municipality."
