Prefer Night Sessions Area Council Meetings

Esqueusing Township and Georgetown have endorsed an Acton resolution calling for evening area council meetings under regional government. The Acton resolution, passed earlier this month, urges a commitment to evening meetings so potential candidates for election can determine their availability for office. The resolution also notes that evening meetings would be more convenient for the public for attendance. Acton recommends that the majority of council and committee meetings be held during evening hours. Reeve Tom Hill of Esqueusing said he could support the intent of the resolution, but couldn't guarantee its adoption in practice. Coun. Richard Howitt said evening meetings have been assumed, but have never been spelled out.

French Club Barn Dance

Georgetown French Group has been granted permission to hold a dance in a barn on the property of Miss Therese St. Jean in Esqueusing Township, on 15 Sideroad. Township council granted the permission, Monday, and also cleared the way for the group to apply for a banquet licence from the Liquor Licence Board of Ontario. Council permission was given with the understanding that such application would not become a regular event. The group will hold its dance Sept. 15.

Have Until Aug. 28 If Left Off List

An obvious sign that elections are on the horizon is the flapping of voters' lists on telephone poles and other public spots. The preliminary voters' lists are already posted, and voters have only until Tuesday, Aug. 28, to apply at any of the three municipal buildings to ask for a correction or revision. For the voter who will be out of town on election day, Oct. 1, proxy voting is a little more complicated. The proxy vote will be Saturday, September 29, at all three north Halton municipal offices, Acton, Esqueusing and Georgetown. Anyone wishing to empower someone to vote for him or her, must pick up an application between Sept. 11 and 23. The certificate must be filed by September 23 at 5 p.m.

Okay Permit For Building

In a recorded vote, Monday, Esqueusing Township gave permission to the Acton Legion branch for a building permit. One dissenting voice was Coun. George Maltby. Reeve Tom Hill, deputy reeve Len Cox and councillors Richard Howitt and Wilfrid Leale voted in favor. Coun. Maltby said he was voting No as a matter of record. Council had refused similar applications in the past from other sources, he said, on the basis of an official plan, due soon, and change of use regulations. The Acton permit will involve agricultural land being used for recreational purposes. Coun. Maltby said he was voting to be consistent with past decisions.

\$50 Per Bed Hospital Levy

A levy of \$50 per bed is being applied by Esqueusing Township to the 70-bed Georgetown and District Memorial Hospital. The levy, permitted by provincial regulation, is in lieu of taxes. Reeve Tom Hill told township council, Monday, that the hospital will apply to the provincial government for a grant to cover the cost of the municipal levy. The hospital is located on land outside the westerly limits of the Town of Georgetown, in Esqueusing. The town owns the property. Necessary enabling bylaw was given three readings by the township council.
