Thirty-One Thefts On The July Docket

Three thefts involving goods worth over \$200 and 28 thefts with values under \$200 were investigated by Georgetown police during July according to that department's activity report for the month. Other crime statistics showed six break-ins, one auto theft, two assaults, and one case of fraud. Nine persons were injured in six motor accidents while 12 other accidents did not involve injury. Eight of the accidents investigated resulted in more than \$200 damage. The July statistics also show three missing persons, three lost children, 16 occurrences involving juveniles, four bicycles found, 85 property checks, and 38 properties found to be insecure. The department's fleet of four vehicles ran up 12,770 miles during the report period.
