

## Two To Hospital After \$1,600 Crash

A car, owned by Alan Harvey, 112 Prince Charles Dr. had crossed church parking lot, the left rear fender crumpled, Saturday night.

It was hit by a car driven by Laird Brisbois, of Irlington, as he was making a left turn into the parking lot from Maple Avenue. The Brisbois car skidded into the parked Harvey car.

Damage to each car was approximately \$100. Robert Campbell of Brampton, and Gordon Willis, 84 Duncan Dr., were taken to Georgetown hospital with cuts and bruises. Late Saturday night, after a car crash.

The Campbell car was travelling along Delrex Boulevard when it hit a parked car owned by Edward Dallman, 331 Delrex Blvd. The left rear fender and trunk of the parked Dallman car were badly damaged with estimates of \$1,000. Damage to the front right side, grill and rad of the Campbell car was put at \$600.

Thirteen-year-old Michael Quigley, R.R. 2, Georgetown, was treated at Georgetown hospital for abrasions, after he fell off his bicycle on Maple Avenue, near the town water works. The mishap occurred Friday afternoon. He was released from hospital after treatment.

### Car Crumpled

A spectacular rear end collision at Water and Guelph streets, Tuesday at 4:30 p.m. crumpled the back of an automobile, pushing the trunk into the back seat. The driver of the car, Anabelle Wilson, 120 Mountainview Rd. S., was taken to Georgetown hospital, badly shaken up, but otherwise just bruised.

The car was hit from behind by a dump truck owned by Lisgar Construction of Bolton, and driven by Orazio Bisolchi, of Toronto. The car was close to being a total wreck with damage estimated at \$2,000. Damage to the front of the truck was \$200.
