

Fire Calls Are Down

Fire calls were down in Georgetown and Esqueping in September, Georgetown Fire Chief Ken Bultema reports. There were six calls answered in Georgetown and nine in Esqueping, for a total of 15. A year ago, the total was 15 in Georgetown and one in Esqueping, 16 in all. There have been 113 alarms answered to date this year, 67 of them in Georgetown. That is up from 1972's total of 104, 77 in Georgetown and 27 in Esqueping. Of September's alarms, seven were to buildings, three to accidents, two open fires and three others. Negligence caused nine fires, accidents one, maintenance three and other, two. Damage in September was placed at \$1,350, up from \$1,200 in September of last year. Loss for the year, to date, at \$72,200, is down substantially from the \$83,940 to date in 1972.
