Wanted Parole Man Goes To Jail

Wilfred Fisher told a story of job-jumping and hearthreak be found in four years following his release from Kingston Penitentiary.

The provincial court in Milton listened attentively to his tale before hearing he was on his way back to the pen.

Sentenced to a 10-year term for possession of counterfelt money, he will likely serve the

CRIMINAL LIFE In passing sentence, Judge William Sharpe said he could reach no other conclusion than that Fisher was persisting in leading a criminal life.

There's not much hope of rehabilitation," he said. have a duty to protect the public."

Fisher took the stand to explain his history in a subdued sad voice. His criminal past, that involves 117 convictions for a variety of offences, took him to Fort Leavenworth Prison in the United States. With 14 other prisoners he staged a breakout that led to an additional five year term in that prison.

Strangely, his association with crime began in Acton, where in he was involved in a dispute over a \$1 bill at a local restaurant. He was charged with theft of the dollar which resulted, he said because he had been short changed.

Sentence was suspended in the Milton Court when he agreed to return to a job at a wartime factory in Toronto. . In 1950 he was sentenced to an

eight year term at Fort Leavenworth that eventually led to his unsuccessful escape

He said the original sentences resulted from a chain of events with American police. He was stopped on the highway, he said, while driving a car he had begus to purchase while in

According to U.S. law at the time, he explained, it was illegal to take a vehicle across state lines before it was completely paid for. He said the car was seized, and with it he lost the down payments and further payments already made on the

vehicle. As well, he was given a three year suspended sentence, out of consideration, he said, for the fact that he was a Canadian unfamiliar with the law.

Later however, in anger at the scizure, he stole a second car to make up for the lost vehicle. He was arrested, returned to Florida and convicted and sentenced to three years imprisonment for the theft. As well, the three year suspended sentence was invoked, for a total term of six years to be served at Fort Leavenworth.

Much later still, by that time entrenched into a criminal record, the criminal record that had come to total 117 convictions, Fisher appealed for supervision at the completion of a prison term at Kingston. With a month left in his prison

sentence he applied for parole.
"I felt I would have been better off under supervision," he told Judge Sharpe.

He wanted parote after the Kingston prison term, he said, because: "I would have at least been watched. I would have had someone to go to."

The list of charges against Fisher were all compiled in South Central Ontario area, in a radius about his last home in Scotland, south of Brantford,

GUELPH OFFENCES Two of the charges, in October of last year, and January, 1973 and in February, 1973, stemmed from offences committed in Guelph. 
