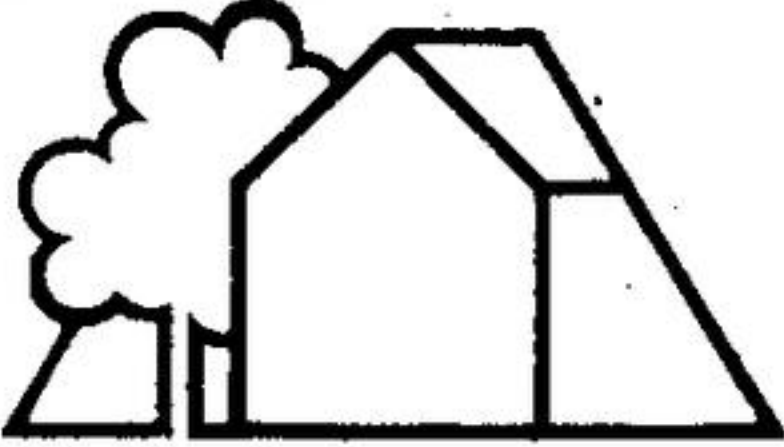

**Snowmobilers Charged**

The week of December 30, 1973 to January 5, 1974 saw police officers from Milton detachment of the Ontario Provincial Police investigate 41 general occurrences. Included in this number were: 2 break and enters, 3 thefts, 1 domestic complaint, 2 persons charged for violating the liquor control act, 2 disturbances, 1 complaint about dogs loose, 7 persons charged for violating the motorized snow vehicles act, 1 car fire, 1 assault, 1 occurrence of damage to property, 1 trespassing complaint, and 1 hunting complaint. The remaining occurrences were minor in nature and required little time to clear.

During this reporting period officers also investigated 10 collisions involving 16 vehicles with property damage estimated to total \$9,921.00. Six persons were injured in 4 of these collisions. Seven drivers have been summoned to appear in provincial court in Milton for traffic violations directly related to their respective collision. Causes of these collisions have been attributed to: inattentive driving, unsafe and improper turns, following too closely and speed too fast for road, weather or traffic conditions.

Three persons were injured when 2 trucks were involved in a collision on 25 highway just south of Acton on Thursday, January 3, 1974. Both drivers, Gordon Paggitt, 36 years, RR 3 Guelph and William James Robins, 37 years, 189 Queen St. N., Hamilton, and Barbara Rankin, 29 years, RR 3 Guelph, a passenger in the Paggitt vehicle were injured. Property damage was estimated to total \$2,550.00. On Saturday, January 5, 1974 Edgar A. Taylor, 23 years, 206 Elmwood Cr., Milton, was injured when he was operating his 1971 snow vehicle on the Bruce Trail. A

ski on the snow vehicle struck a rock resulting in Mr. Taylor being thrown from the vehicle. His vehicle continued on out of control and struck a tree. Damage to the snow vehicle was estimated to be \$200.00. Drivers! Winter driving need not be hazardous if you always adjust to winter conditions as they occur. 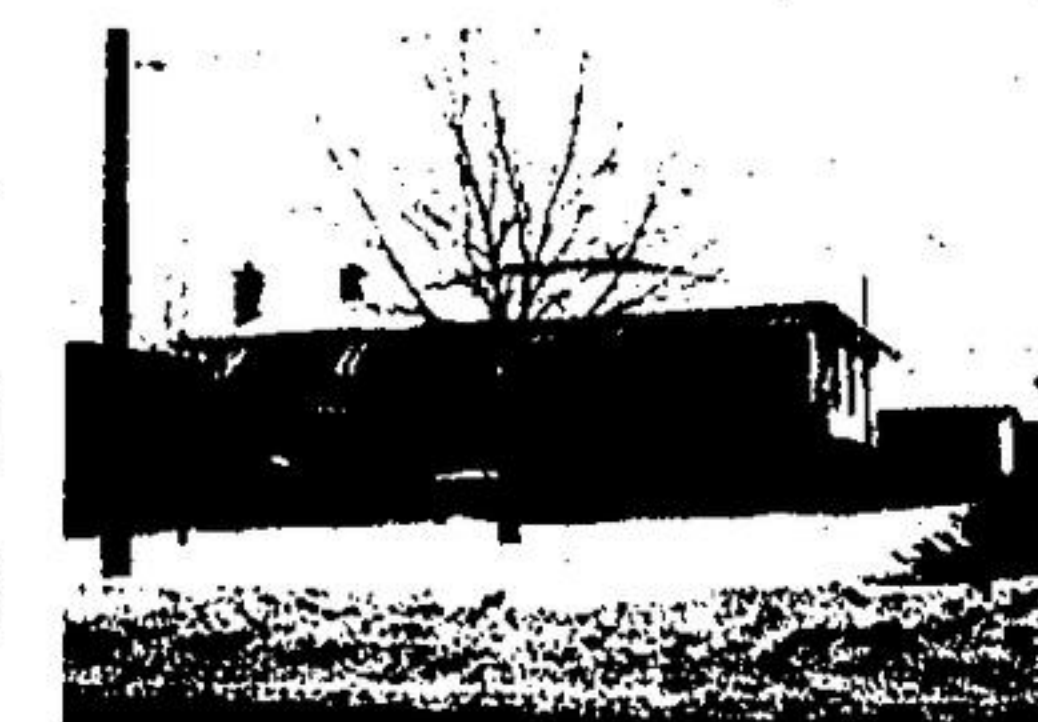

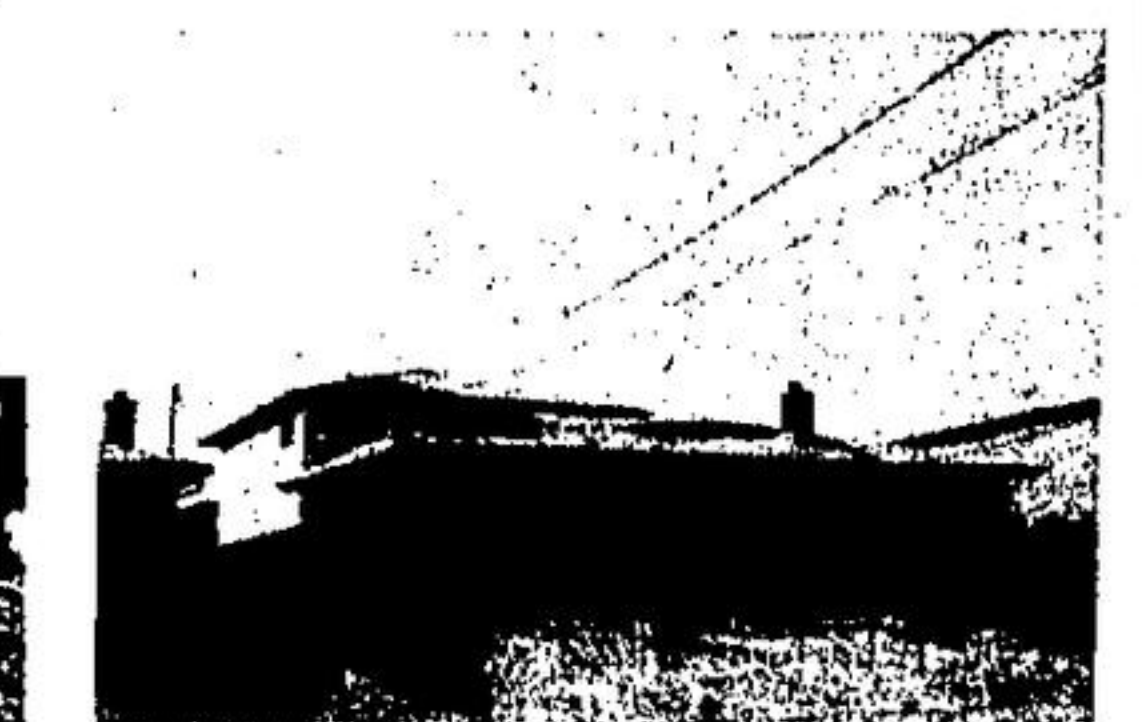
