Six members offered to have their names put on a referral list of those willing to baby-sit for any family facing an emergency situation.

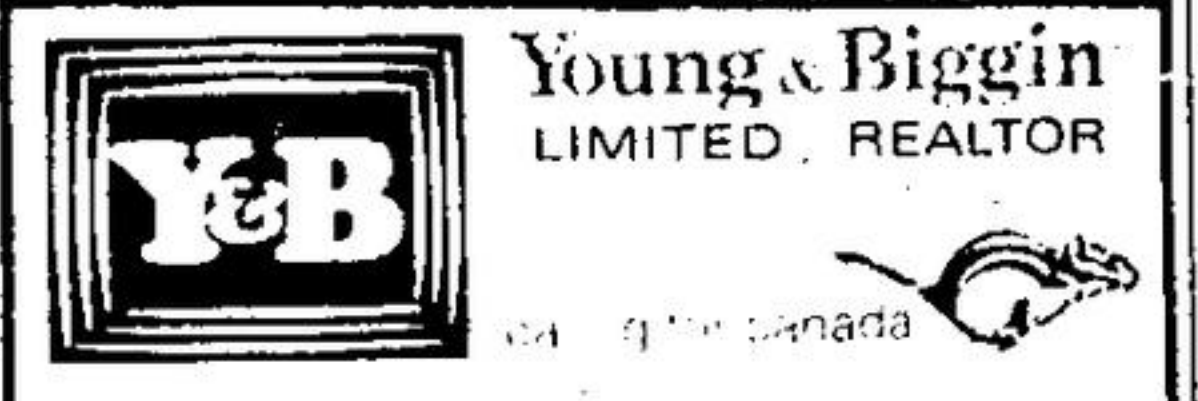
