Installing a Bypass Tub Enclosure

All Bypass enclosures have same basic parts: A, 2 side (or wall) channels; B, Top & bottom channels; C, 2 Doors; D, 2 Handle-Bars. Installation:

1. Mark-off a centre line along length of tub's rim.
2. Secure side channels to walls at each end of tub (centred on centre line on rim of tub).
3. Ensure each side channel is plumb by using a level.
4. Measure distance between 2 side channels & cut bottom channel to right measure. (This bottom channel has drain holes — they should be placed towards inside of tub).
5. Tub caulk can now be used on underside of channel for a watertight joint.
6. Prepare the 2 doors for installation by installing the roller wheels to door tops.
7. Measure distance between side channels at top and cut top channel to right length — now install (the top channel has tracks, this allows rollers on each door to rest into its correct track. If side walls are out of plumb, you will generally find extra holes at top of each door, so rollers can be adjusted).
8. Doors are usually inserted so that the shiny side of the glass is on inside of tub.
9. Install 1 level bar to each door: 1 on the inside and 1 on the outside.

Glass Tub Enclosure

This attractive tub enclosure has tempered frosted glass doors for extra safety. Two door by-pass for easy access to every part of the tub. Smooth-faced heavy gauge aluminum frame. The overhead ball-bearing rollers provide quieter, smoother operation. Two rigid towel bars. Doors lift out for easy cleaning. Comes in the standard height of 58".
