

Close Doors, So Two Leave

Two Oakville members of the Halton region council abruptly left the meeting last Wednesday when an "in camera" session was agreed by a majority of the councillors.

Terry Mannell and Carl Eriksen left in protest of the session which they termed "unnecessary." Coun. Mannell had voiced his dissent prior to council passing the motion.

"Does regional council have the authority to hold an in camera session," Coun. Mannell asked regional chairman Allan Masson. "If we are not planning to speak about personnel or property acquisition, I see no reason to go in camera."

After leaving, Coun. Eriksen said that the session did not concern either personnel or land acquisition. "I will not participate at in camera meetings for any other reason," he added. The majority of council agreed to the motion presented by Halton Hills Coun. Ric Morrow. Coun. Morrow told the councillors that they could decide to allow the press back in after listening to him for 10 minutes.

"This is just a bull session to discuss communications between council and senior staff members," said Coun. Morrow. "Within five or 10 minutes it should be obvious if the press should be allowed back in."

When Coun. Morrow took the chair to begin the session, he instructed members of the press to leave the room. Four reporters refused to leave, asking Coun. Morrow if he "was ordering" them to leave.

Coun. Morrow informed the four men that he could not order anyone to leave the room, but "council has voted to go in camera and that does not include members or press." After 25 minutes, Coun. Paul Preston opened the door and asked everyone to return, announcing, "We've decided not to go that route, we're open again."

When the press was back, council listened to reports from the treasurer Don Farmer, solicitor Noel Bates and purchasing agent Roy Higgins. The senior members of staff succeeded in requesting council to reverse their decision against hiring assistants.

Two weeks ago, council voted against a recommendation from the administration and finance committee, headed by Coun. Ric Morrow, to hire a senior buyer to help Mr. Higgins, a junior solicitor for Mr. Bates and two new secretaries.

After the meeting, regional chairman Allan Masson explained that the in camera session was an exception to his general rule that all meetings would be open except in cases of personnel or land acquisition.

"This time, council democratically decided it wanted to carry on its discussion in camera and that is its privilege," he said.
