And what of protests? Nary a one. It seems that people can get used to anything.

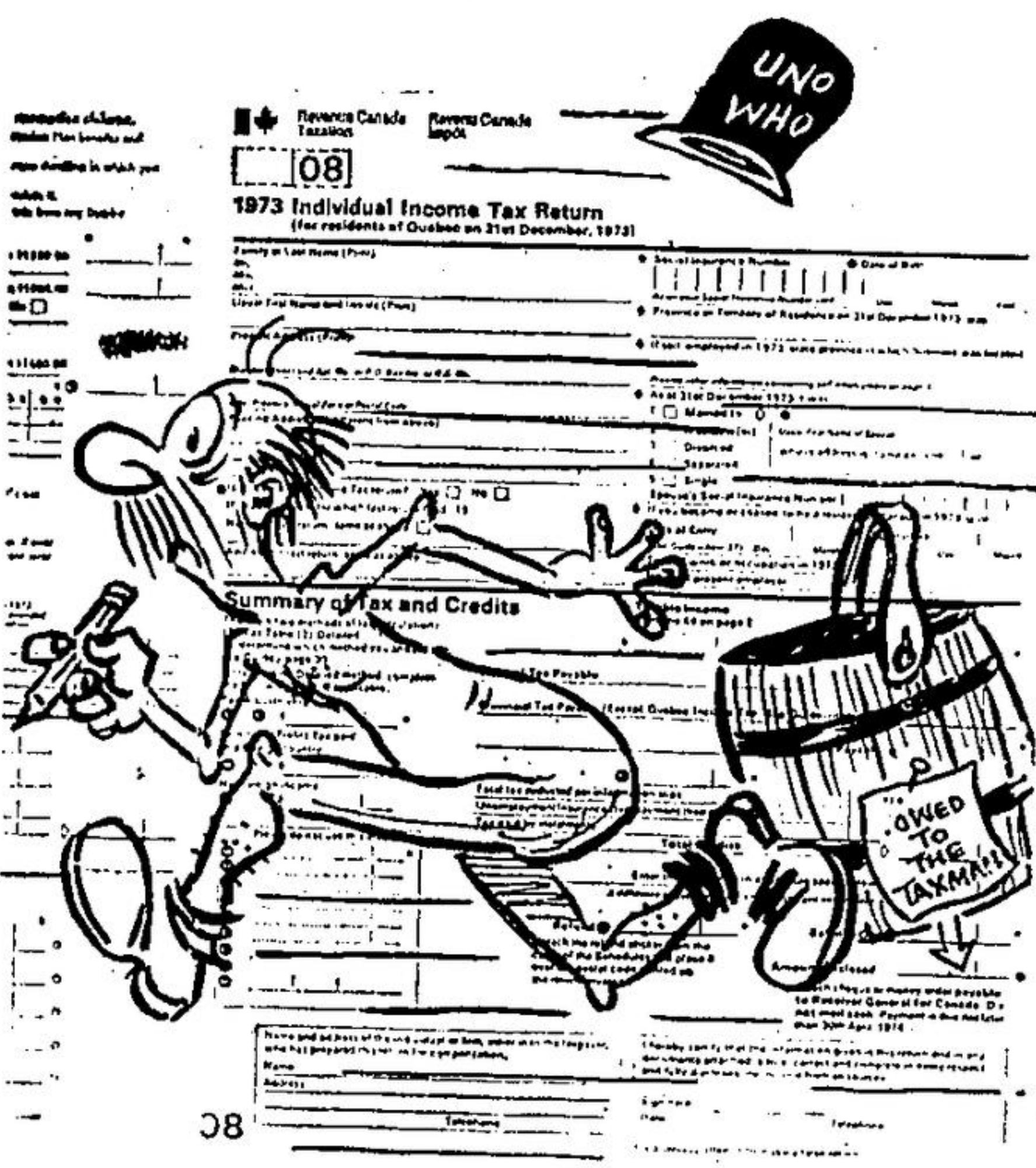
ECHOES FROM THE PAST

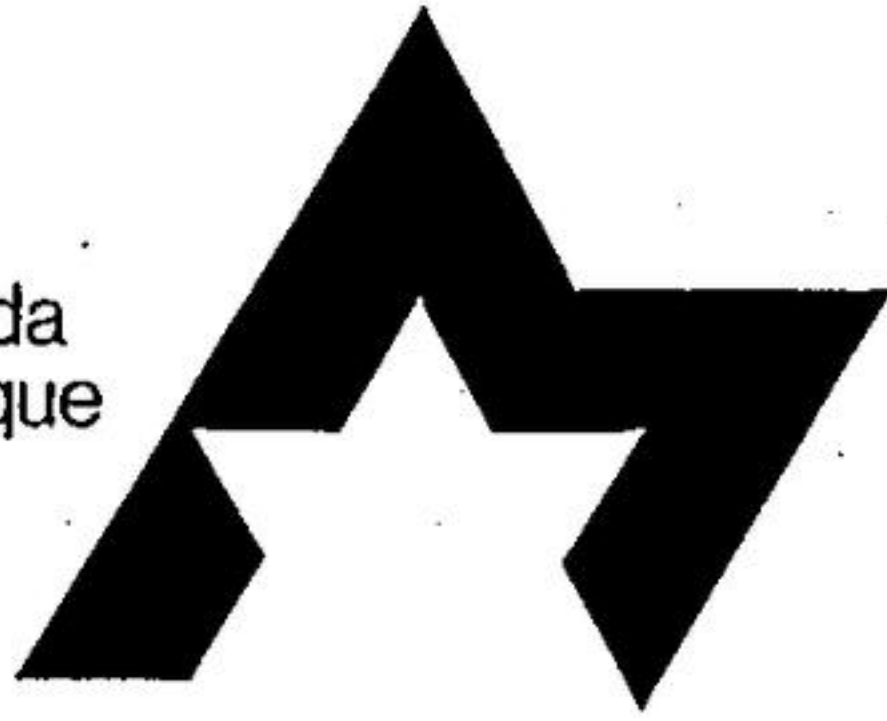
