Trees For Canada Project

Once again, this year, 300 boys of North Halton district of the Boy Scouts of Canada are planning a Trees for Canada project. This year, the areas to be planted are approximately 11 acres near Erin and a further 10 acres at Silver Creek conservation area, on April 27. The trees, which will include white and silver maple, red pine, white spruce and white pine, white cedar and red oak, are being obtained from the Credit Valley conservation authority without whose help the project would not be possible. This will be the third year of such projects for the North Halton district Boy Scouts. Since its origin in this area, the idea has spread to other areas in Canada.

Union Gas Has Acquired Major Holdings Interest

Union Gas Ltd. has announced that it has acquired approximately a 30 per cent interest in Major Holdings and Developments Limited of Waterloo. Union purchased 600,000 of the common shares of Major Holdings on April 18 at a cost of about \$2,200,000. The shares were obtained from Abram Wiebe and from Fambau Limited, a holding company controlled by Mr. Wiebe. Major Holdings has been engaged in real estate development in the Kitchener-Waterloo area for 17 years, and recently began expanding its activities throughout southwestern Ontario. During 1973, Major had gross sales of \$4 million and net earnings of \$556,000. During the past two years, Union Gas has been associated with Major Holdings in the financing of the 800 acre Pioneer Park community development at Kitchener. Commenting on the share acquisition, Union's vice president, finance W. G. Stewart noted that, for some time now, the company has been considering various diversification moves.
