# Intensive Work Goes On Behind The Voting Scene

A general election in Canada is not only a time of political rhetoric. It is also a period of intensive work, behind the scenes, by thousands of people performing an essential function in Canada's electoral procedure - the process of compiling complete and accurate lists of electors eligible to vote.

Working under the direction of the Chief Electoral Officer of Canada, Jean Marc Hamel, more than 230,000 persons share the direct responsibility of ensuring efficient operation of the complex administrative procedures leading up to the July 8th vote.

You also share that responsibility, indirectly, as

one of about 13 million Canadians eligible to vote in this election. Your responsibility is to check for your name on the preliminary list of voters compiled from the May 20-25 enumeration.

Printed copies of the list have been posted publicly in each of the nearly 63,000 polling divisions across Canada. In addition, copies are being mailed to the residence of each enumerated voter in urban polling divisions.

**REVISION PHASE**  
This is the revision phase of the electoral process. It is a time to catch omissions, duplications and errors in the listing of eligible electors. The

deadline for changes is June 19th.

In urban polling divisions, the revising is done by a revising officer, assisted by two revising agents.

If you live in a population centre of more than 5,000, you are an urban voter, and must contact the returning officer of your electoral district if your name is not on the preliminary posted list. If you wish, you may ask the returning officer to send the revising agents to your home for the information required to have your name included in the official list of electors.

Compiling and preparing lists of eligible voters is the direct responsibility of the returning officer in each of the 264 electoral districts in Canada.

The lists are used for only one election, they discarded. It is estimated that approximately 98 per cent of all eligible voters are registered for each election. You can do your part in maintaining that high standard by making sure you are on the official list of electors for the July 8th general election.

**ADVANCE POLLS**  
Because this election is being held at a time when many Canadians will be on vacation,

there is greater than usual interest in the advance polls. They are held June 29th and July 1st, and are available for anyone who will be away from home July 8th, for any reason.

Unless you are on the voters' list, however, you may not take advantage of the advance poll.

**More Liquor Offences Reported By OPP**  
There has been a sharp increase in the number of persons charged with offences under the Liquor Control Act in the criminal code, reported the Action OPP.

Qualified urban electors lose their vote if they are not on the official list after June 21st.

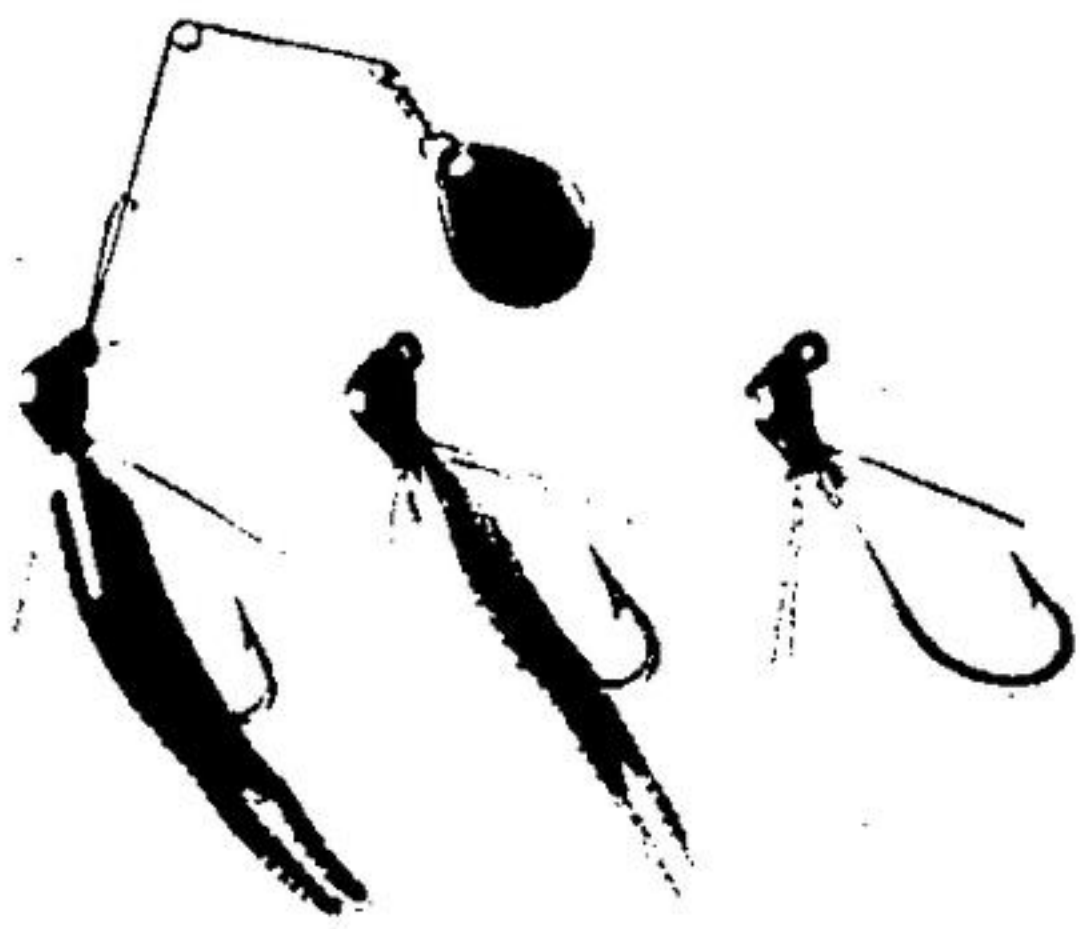
Rural electors may still vote July 8th, if someone on the list votes for them.

To be eligible to vote, you must be at least 18 by July 8th.

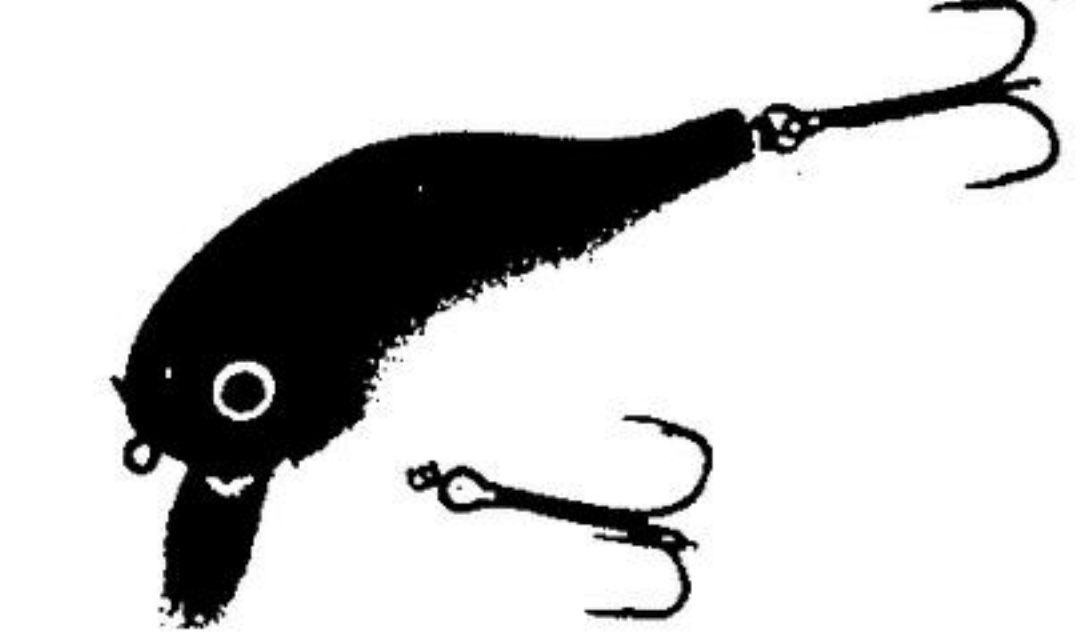

## ONTARIO OUTDOORS Fishing Is Great In Baptiste Lake

Where to go, fishing that is. This one in the Bancroft area, Baptiste Lake.

This is a large lake and can be very confusing. I found that the local folk were not too eager to give out any good spots, but the sporting goods stores will surely help you out.

I discovered a good spot by trial and error and a little flattery with a fisherman that is retired and lives on the lake. On Hwy No. 28 or No. 62, go through Bancroft and turn at the road next up from the one to the town of Baptiste. There are plenty of cottages to rent in this region and the facilities are never crowded. If you wish public docking facilities then go to Baptiste, and go up the lake till you see the radio antenna on your left. Get these at your back and troll in the direction of the long arm or bay a little to the right. Troll deep and slow and get yourself some real good walleye. As close to the shore as you dare (100 feet) and straight. Try a ZEBCO DOLL TOP SECRET. That is the name of a re-designed floating-diving lure that is a "rattler" style of lure. It has a built in rattle, and this attracts the fish. It has proved effective for both kinds of Bass and for Walleye, comes in 1/4 oz. and 1/2 oz. and ten colors. Another good lure by ZEBCO is the new Jawbreaker Spinner Baits. These are available with a weed guard called the DOLL FAN GUARD. This is one more way to beat the weeds.

Here is another way of cooking your catch. It is called planking, and is simple enough to prepare. Weave green sticks in the shape of a anow shoe, two sets. Split your fish open like a book, place between these two and bind together. Turn over a good bed of coals, or place beside a rock or log and turn occasionally. A good hint when you are out fishing, if you are transporting your fish, remove the gills. The gills will make the fish deteriorate faster than you may believe.

Enforcement check at International Bridge, Sault Ste. Marie a success - Bill Daniber

Regular road checks of anglers and hunters are being held in this district with increasing frequency as part of the district Fish and Wildlife Management Program. Such checks are held to determine the numbers and species of fish and game taken by sportsmen and also to ensure that our laws and regulations are being observed.

Conservation Officers from Sault Ste. Marie and Wawa Districts undertook a border check on May 25, 26 and 27, in which 4,020 non-resident anglers were interviewed when returning to the United States on the Memorial Day weekend. These anglers exported a total of 13,666 fish comprised of the following species:

- Walleye..... 4,875
- Northern pike..... 4,057
- Brook trout..... 1,832
- Lake trout..... 1,023
- Whitefish..... 1,213
- Rainbow trout..... 148
- Perch..... 718

A total of 38 violations were detected. These included:

- 1 Over legal limit of fish..... 22
- 2 No angling licence..... 5
- 3 Transporting fish in a manner prohibited by regulations..... 4
- 4 Loaded firearm in motor vehicle..... 2
- 5 Possession of grouse in closed season..... 1
- 6 Take fish in closed season..... 2

A total of \$3,085.00 was collected from violators as payment in fines for these offences.

## Olympic Jumpers Meet In Lord Dufferin Show

Spectators at the fourth annual Lord Dufferin Horse Show in Orangeville, Friday and Saturday, will have the opportunity to see in action Olympic jumpers of the past and of the future.

The 50 best riders in Canada, some of them equal to the best in the world, and more than 90 of the best horses will compete. There will be \$8,750 in prize money in eight events.

The Show opens Friday morning June 21 at 9 a.m. when there will be five events in the preliminary and intermediate jumps and the open-fault-and-out contests.

The big event of Friday will be, at 7 p.m., the Courvoisier Classic. This is a jumping derby, a tough competition introduced into Canada last year. It will attract the more experienced riders and horses.

Saturday morning, commencing at 10 will be the modified Grand Prix. The main event will be the Grand Prix of Dufferin at 1:30 p.m., that afternoon.

Canadian riders and their horses have brought many honors to Canada in Olympic and other international competitions. These include gold medals.
