Yoder Canada

Yoder Equipment Canada Ltd., began operations in 1967 to serve the growing metalworking needs of the community.

The present factory on Todd Road, covers 25,000 sq. ft. of space where Yoder machinery is designed, built and tested for Canadian manufacturing plants.

Yoder manufactures and operates such machines as cold roll forming machines, pipe and tube mills, slitters and other auxiliary equipment. Resistance-weld and induction-weld mills can manufacture tubing or pipe to five-sixteenths of an inch.

All types of shapes of steel are possible from cold roll forming machines including tubular, square and rectangular shapes all of different thickness.

The finished products such as tube and pipe rolls, cutoffs and package slitters are distributed to companies which use them in the manufacture of square tube furniture, curtain rods or roof deck siding.

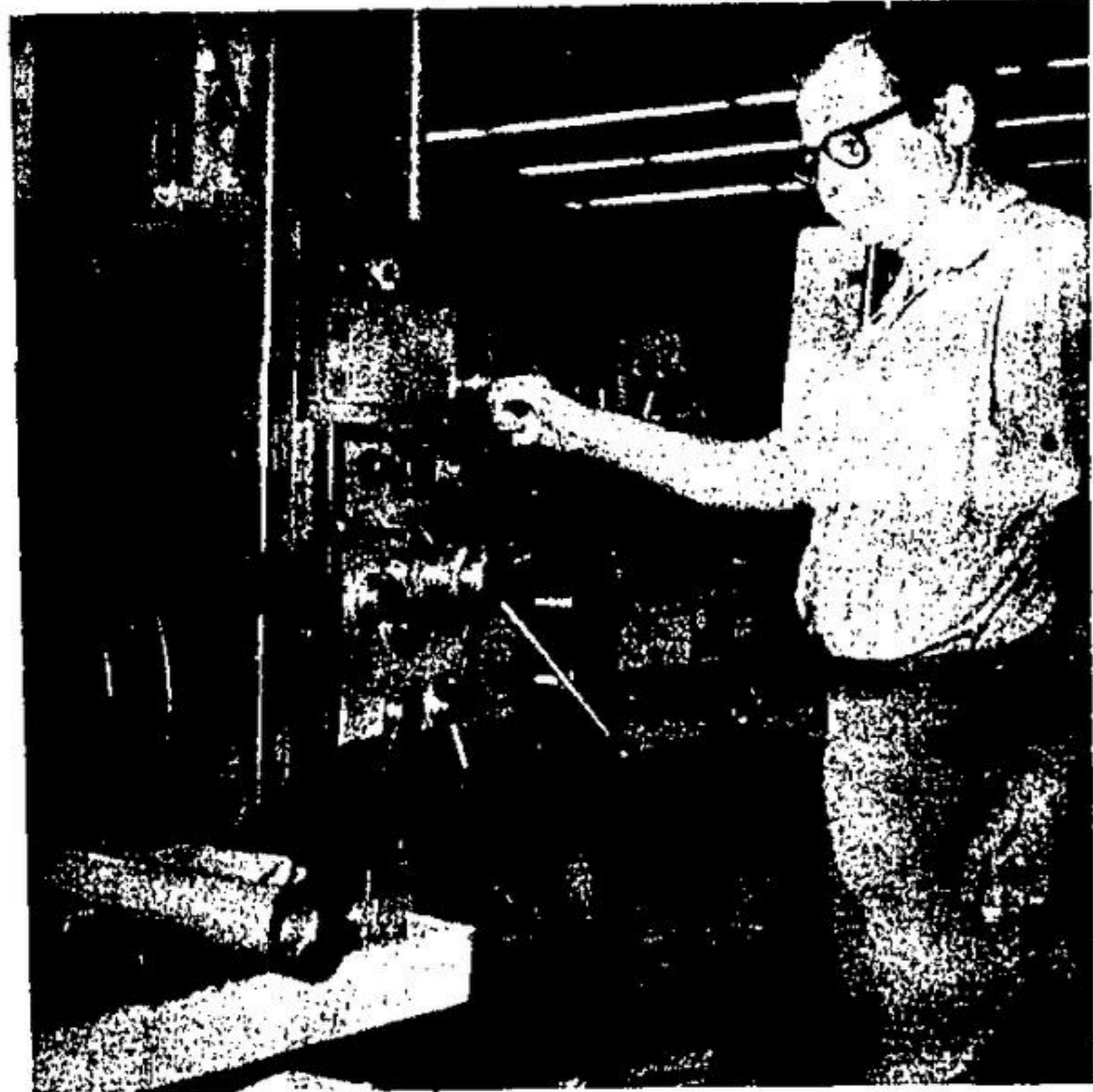

Travelways operates the transit system in Brampton plus direct service to Toronto International Airport. Last June the company bought out the Georgetown transportation services and have recently acquired C.H. Norton Bus Lines of Burlington. "We are growing and expanding," said Lawrence Kirby, district manager, "especially in tours."

Travelways operates bus service in three categories: 1) school buses and activity buses - These traditional school buses seat about 48 persons. A familiar sight along the Georgetown roads, these vehicles carry students, senior citizens' clubs for day outings, school classes for field excursions, day camps and athletic teams.

2) mini buses - These vehicles with large tinted picture windows and reclining seats can carry 23 passengers. 3) travel cruisers - These are the familiar highway journeymen that rule the road with the mammoth trucks. Seating 49 persons, they provide reclining seats, air conditioning, card tables, washrooms and a P.A. system.

The Georgetown division has become the hub of bus travel for the surrounding area of Brampton, Acton, Bramalea and Orangeville. The bus service industry is expanding with Georgetown as the main depot in this region.



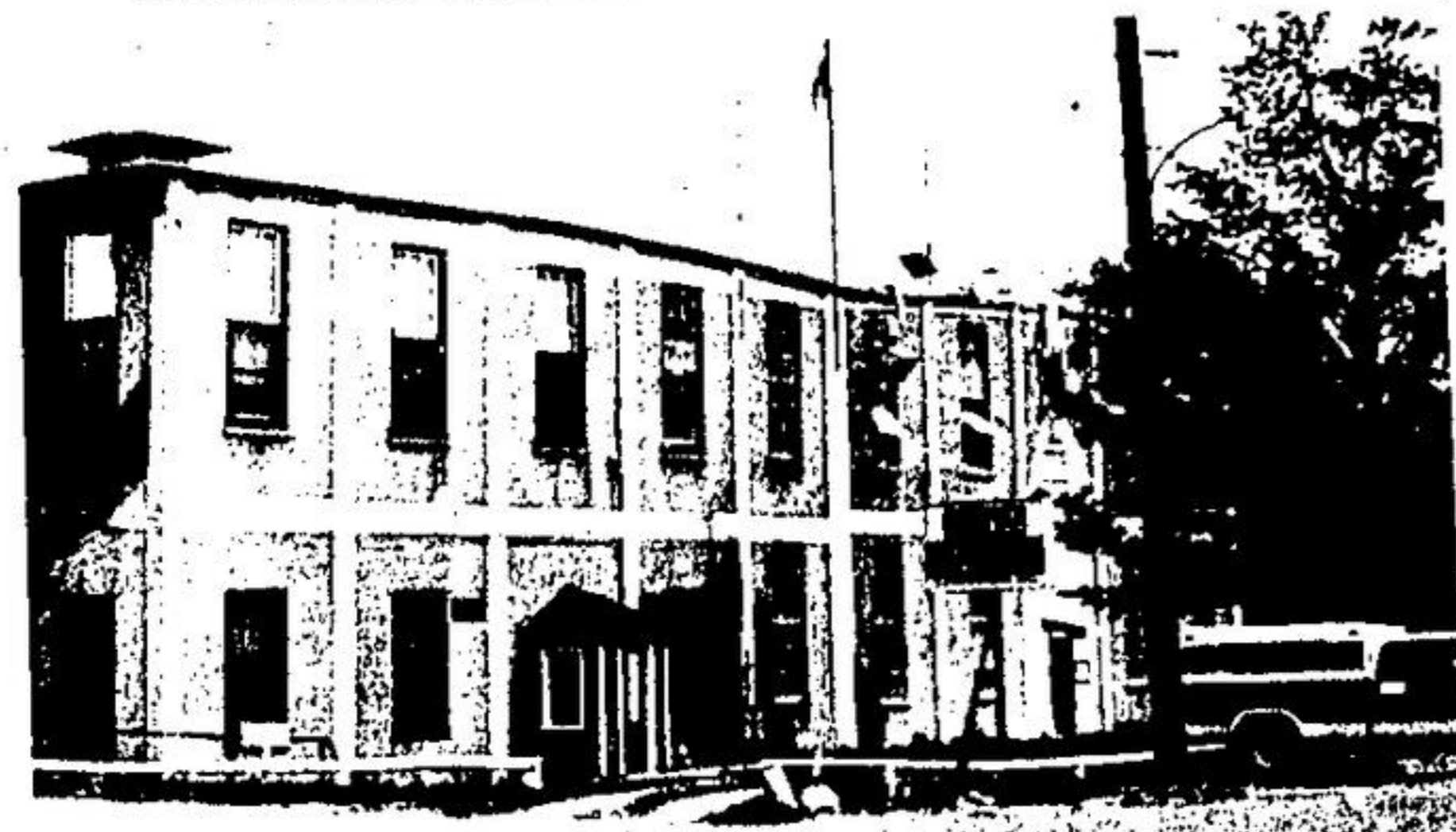

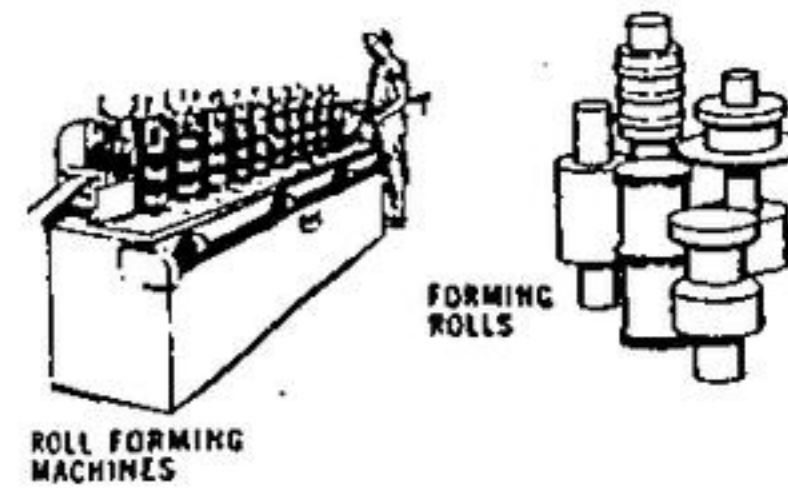

All types of shapes are possible, including tubular as well as square and rectangular, ranging from the thinnest up to 3/4" thick and from a fraction of an inch to 80 inches or more in width.



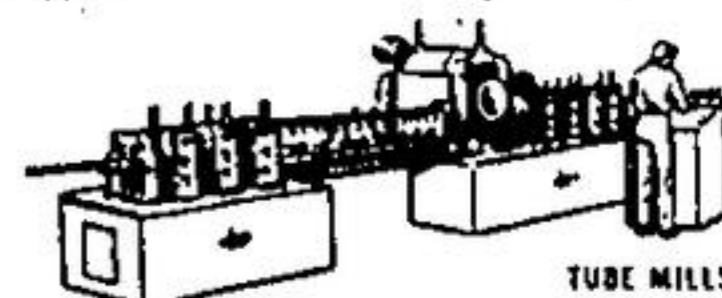
SLITTERS

"Standard" Yoder drive or pull coil slitting lines are capable of handling coils in widths ranging from 12" to 72", and gauges from .015" to .250". Sheet slitters with identical specifications are also available.



PIPE AND TUBE MILLS

Resistance-weld and induction-weld mills manufacture tubing or pipe from 5/16" to 20" in diameter. Tube mills handle gauges from .020" to .165". Pipe mills handle gauges from .091" to .560". Speeds range from 50 to 300 fpm depending on material, wall thickness and diameter.
