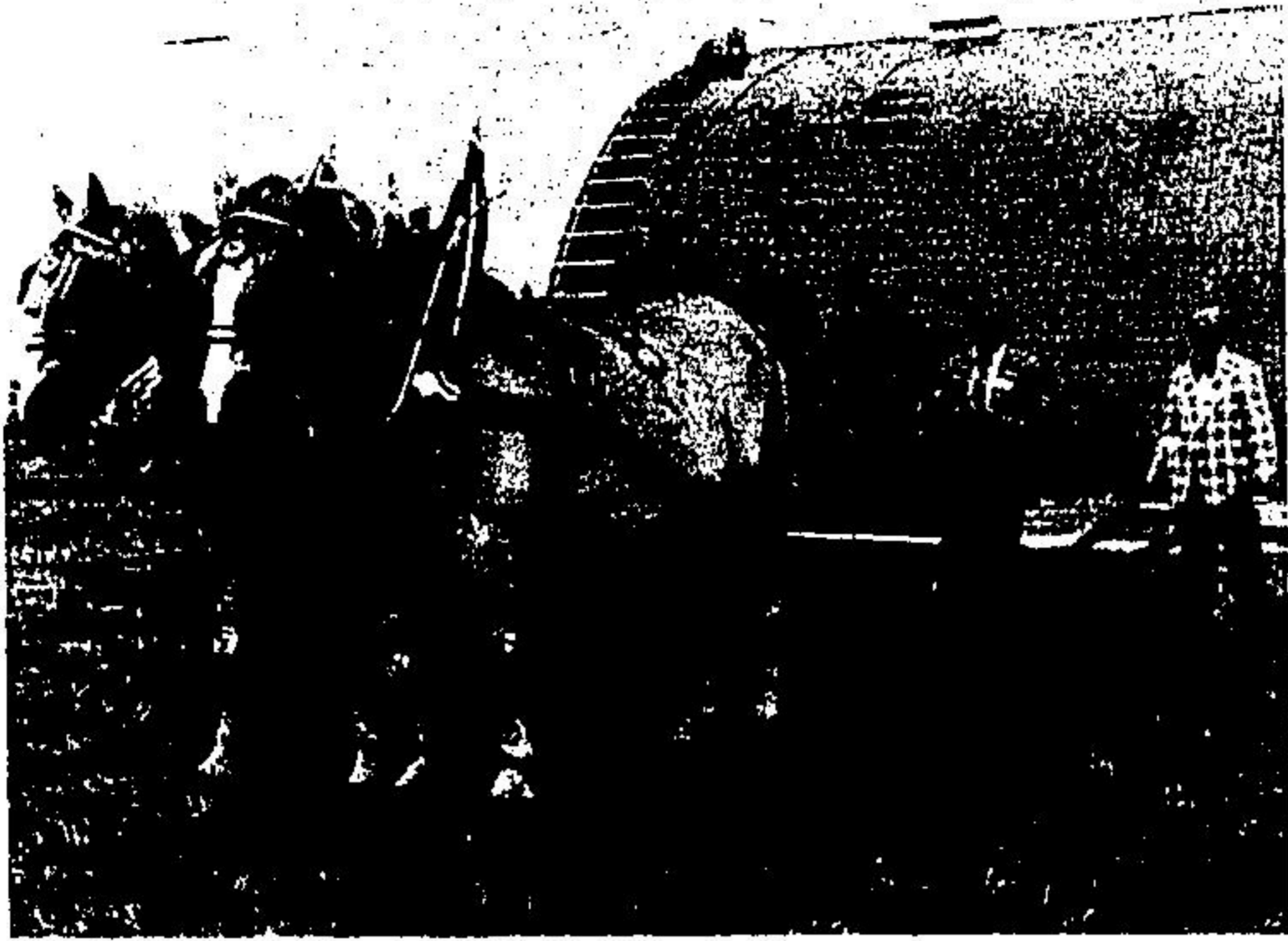


# See Halton's Plowmen Compete Against The Best

## Display At Plowing Match Focus On Sheridan College

Sheridan College will be significantly represented at three different locations during the International Plowing Match south of Georgetown from Sept. 24 to 28.

The main exhibit, located on an 80 by 100 foot lot in tented city, will feature a mobile trailer, information centre and 10 individual island exhibits pictorially representing all schools and divisions within the college.

The annual event also provides the first opportunity for Sheridan to display its newly-designed pennant which will fly atop a 30 foot pole for the duration of the match.

The display will focus special attention on the Sheridan College heavy equipment school which offers various programs in co-operation with

Canada Manpower and a post-secondary program in heavy equipment construction techniques.

In addition, the community services division is offering for the first time this fall, two evening courses which lead to a certificate in farm management. The Principles of Soil and Crop Management and Economics and Finance for the Farm start in November at both the Oakville and Brampton Campus.

Visitors to the Sheridan exhibit can obtain information on these programs and others, view student work from major art studios and pick up their souvenir meter stick, post cards, and special carrying folder and calendars.

Sheridan will also occupy about 150 sq. ft. of display space in the exhibit sponsored by the Regional Municipality of Halton. Other exhibits in this area include the Town of Oakville, the Halton Regional Conservation Authority, Halton Region Museum, 4H Club, Ontario Horticultural Society, Halton Regional Women's Institute, and many other attractions.

In this area, Sheridan will feature continuous college slide presentations, student photography and general program information.

## The Hospitable Spirit Of The Halton People

The hospitable spirit and enthusiasm of the people of Halton will be evident in the many exhibits, including the Town of Oakville display; a walk through exciting conservation environment sponsored by the Halton Region Conservation Authority in conjunction with the University of Guelph; a beef draw every hour in the Halton and Peel Beef Producers exhibit; and a wide variety of other exhibits representative of the interests of the people of Halton.

The central courtyard houses the English style tea garden, sponsored by the Town of Halton Hills. The costumed Georgetown Jaycettes and Acton ladies will be the charming hostesses. Whilst enjoying the atmosphere and

refreshments, continuous entertainment will be provided on stage, sponsored by the Town of Milton and arranged and conducted by Ron Harris. A wide variety of artists and groups will be entertaining throughout the week to provide copious amounts of foot tapping music and sing songs.

The many other attractions, designed to appeal to all tastes, include a mini tractor pull arranged by the Toronto International Dragway and sponsored by the Min-Tractor Pull Association. This exciting demonstration of a garden tractor specially modified to house a 495 horse power engine pitting its strength against a sled many times its own weight, will be staged periodically throughout the day.

In a further effort to show the public what Sheridan has to offer several students from the child studies department have volunteered to organize and operate facilities for a children's activity centre, located on Headquarter's Row.

The centre will run from 9 a.m. to 5.30 p.m. as a place where children from age three and up can busy themselves with games, toys and books for a couple of hours while parents enjoy other aspects of the event.

The plowing match brings

together all services of the community on more than 50 acres for five days - an event which began about 125 years ago with the first provincial exhibition held in Toronto in 1846.

Since then, the matches have expanded to include more competitions, farm machinery demonstrations and now involves the entire community including oil companies, banks, car and truck dealers, household and garden supplies, education and other government agencies.

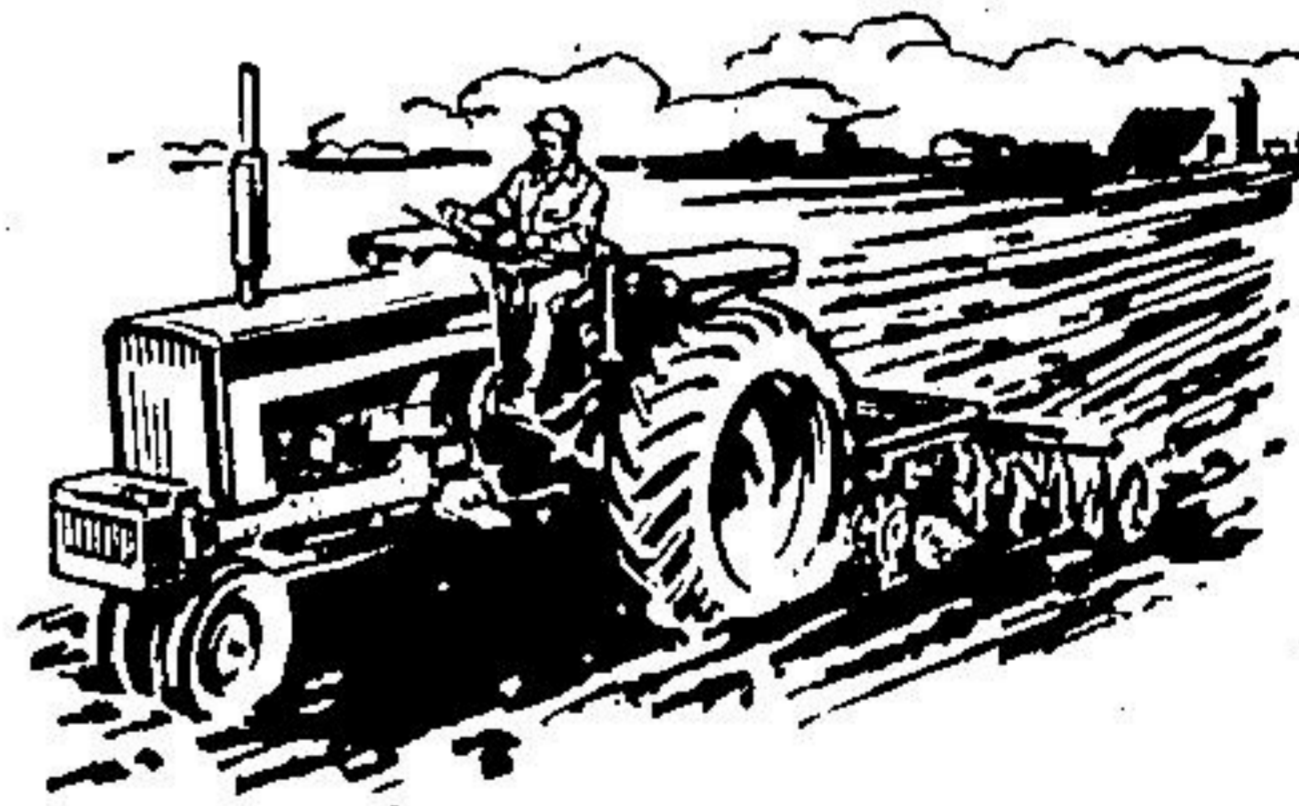
