

12 Bands Will Highlight Show

A total of 12 bands, the best in Canada, two each day will take part in the daily parade, arranged and co-ordinated by Andy Frank, former sheriff of Milton.

TUESDAY, SEPT. 24

The Burlington Teen Tour Band, formed in 1948, is composed of 150 teenage boys and girls, thus making it one of Canada's largest marching bands.

Supervisor of music is Lieutenant Colonel Cliff Hunt. Conductor is Mr. Eric Ford and Manager and Marching Director is Robert D. Webb.

They have played all over Canada and the United States and have been the feature band in the Grey Cup football classic halftime show in 1970-1972 and 1973.

They were participants in the Orange Bowl Parades in Miami; performed at Disney World in Orlando, Florida and participated in Eaton's Santa Claus Parade in 1971-1972 and 1973 in Toronto.

They won four outstanding awards in Parade of Champions in Philadelphia in 1973 and this year performed at the Cotton Bowl Parade in Dallas, Texas.

The Milton Girls Pipe Band, who are in great demand, played in May for the Lions Club at Sudbury and at the Steam Show in Pennsylvania in July. They have 14 members.

WEDNESDAY, SEPT. 25

Durham Girls Drum and Bugle was formed in 1969. There are 85 marching members aged 10 to 17.

They have won three provincial competitions and have performed in competitions all over Ontario. They won a trophy for the best horn

line at the Toronto Exhibition Grand-stand Show.

Shinglers Accordion Band has 17 members; all with at least five years tuition and are affiliated with the Toronto Conservatory of Music.

Mount Forest Cameron Highlanders Pipe Band, under the direction of Pipe Major, Grant MacLellan, have performed continuously since they were formed in 1914.

They have won Best Pipes and Drum trophy six times in the last nine years and have 14 members.

THURSDAY, SEPT. 26

Teeswater Highlanders Pipe Band has 15 members and are a well known marching band, and have been very active in competitions.

Seaford District High School Girls Trumpet Band have 65 members, and are recognized as one of the finest all-girl trumpet bands in Canada.

They were formed in 1967 and have performed all over Ontario and Michigan. Their ages range from 13 to 19 years of age.

FRIDAY, SEPT. 27

Kiwanis Kavaliers are 85 girls and boys between the ages of nine to 14 and were formed in 1971. In 1972 they were the National Novice Junior Champions and have performed all over Ontario and recently in Michigan and New York State.

The Georgetown Girls Pipe Band has 14 members and was organized in 1943 and have been in continuous operation ever since. They are an excellent marching band and have a creditable record in competitions.

Action Citizens Band has been in continuous operation since

1875. In 1973 the Band was awarded first prize in Section III at Toronto Exhibition.

They play for all local celebrations and built and paid for their own music hall. They have 40 members under the leadership of Dr. George Elliott.

Brampton Clown Band are a group of versatile musicians who are in demand at many functions. They have played for eight straight years at the Grape Festival in St. Catharines.

Whitby Brass Band are 40 members and are well known as an excellent marching band and also well known in competitions.
