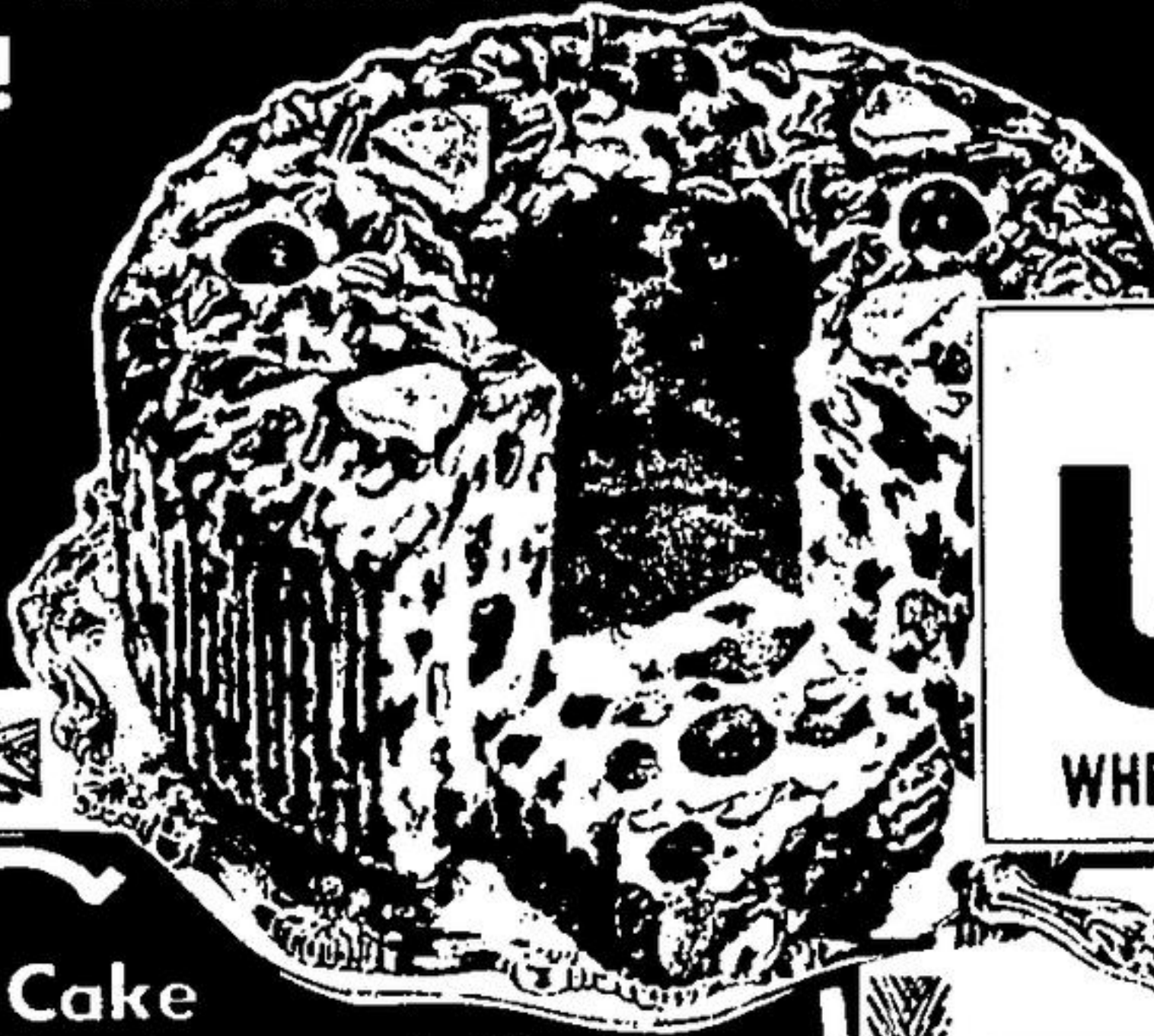


Effective Wednesday, December 4th, 1974 through Wednesday, January 1st, 1975 there will be no price increase on any A&P Label Products.

Yule treat for kids to make

Any child will have fun turning 13 twinkles, one doughnut, a can of ready-to-spread frosting, a few colorful sprinkles and a piece of cardboard into a gay little sleigh with Santa in the driver's seat.

The cardboard is cut into a rectangle the length of two twinkles laid end-to-end and one twinkle wide.

Runners are made by arranging four twinkles so that the long edges of the cardboard rest on the twinkles with half the length of the two front runners extending beyond the cardboard.

The sleigh box is shaped by five twinkles. Two are laid end-to-end on each side of the cardboard. The fifth is cut in half with each half forming an end of the sleigh.

The top of the sleigh-box is three twinkles — one is placed across the back of the sleigh (over a half twinkle and resting on twinkles forming the sides), the remaining two are placed one on each side.

The curl frosting each runner is one-half of a doughnut secured in place with a toothpick. Sleigh and runners are frosted, then sprinkled with red sugar, mixed color nonpareils, chocolate shot, raisins, nuts, fruit loops or whatever colorful edibles are at hand.

Santa is made by cutting the end off a twinkle (to give him a firm base); frosting (a bit heavier for his beard); arranging a face with cinnamon red dots, chocolate chips or raisins; and sprinkling heavily with red sugar for his famous red suit. Or, color some of the frosting with food coloring, leaving white frosting for face and beard. A tiny marshmallow or mint makes a tassel on his hat.

Into the sleigh he goes, with a load of candy for good little boys and girls.

Some stocking stuffers!

Looking for small gifts for stocking stuffers? Here are some ideas to start your thinking.

For the baby — a rattle, a cloth book, perhaps a pull toy if he's toddling, a pretty shirt that he can wear for "company."

For little sister — barrettes and ribbons for her hair, white gloves for special occasions, frilly socks.

For little brother — coloring books and non-toxic crayons or felt tip pens, new accessories for his train set, a license plate for his bicycle with his name spelled out.

For big sister — lipstick, nail polish, eye makeup, cosmetics of all kinds, note paper for her secret letters, a token holder for her bus fare.

For big brother — a magnetized change holder for the dashboard of his car, some "way-out" after-shave, or a T-shirt sporting a funny slogan.

For mother — a pad of memo paper for market lists, ball point pens to keep in strategic places, a pretty handkerchief, gloves.

For father — a key ring with his initial, a pair of driving gloves, a throw-away cigarette lighter, lighter fluid and flints for his chair-side lighter, a tie or a scarf.

For the hobbyist — photography buffs can always use rolls or packs of film, flash bulbs, photo album mounts.

Model plane and ship builders will thank you for sandpaper, turpentine, glue, paint brushes, threaders, clamps, rubber bands and clips.

Would-be writers will appreciate a typewriter ribbon, a ream of paper, a box of carbon paper.

Those who sew and do needlework will enjoy a pretty needle case, a fancy thimble.

Stereo buffs will like an automatic duster for cleaning their records.

For someone going to sunny climes right after the holidays, tuck a bottle of suntan lotion in their stocking.

For the home handyman, how about a roll of friction tape, a box of assorted screws, cup hooks, a box of assorted nails, or even a mini tool kit.
