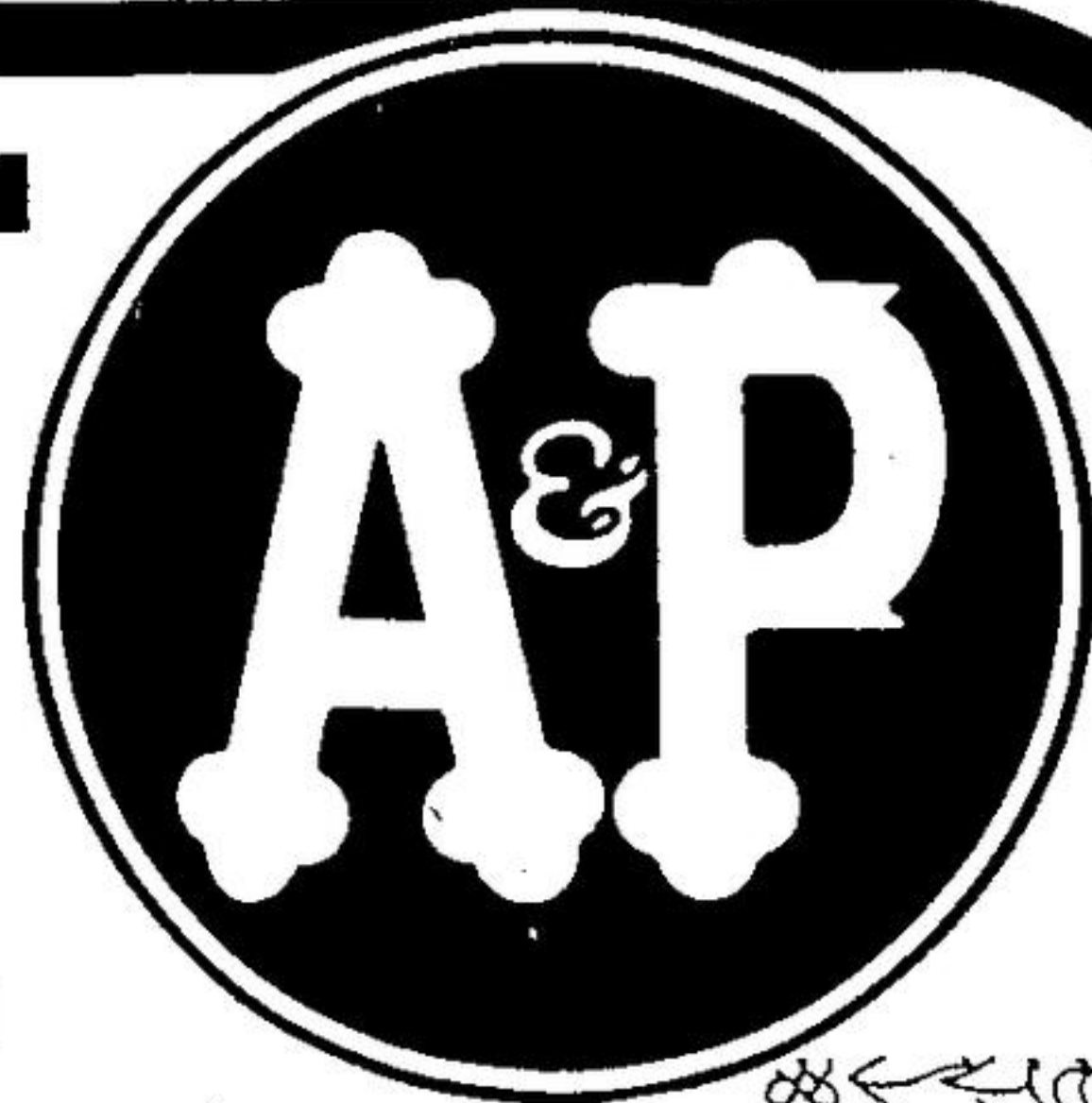

## Halton Hills splits Halton

Halton Hills has managed to neatly slice the region's four member municipalities right in half. The split has sided Halton Hills and Burlington against Oakville and Milton over Halton Hills' request to the Halton Board of Education concerning sale of municipally paid for school property.

Halton Hills had asked the other three municipalities to endorse its request to the board that school properties paid for through local taxes should be returned to the municipality for its use when the property is no longer needed by the board.

The town's request centres on the old Norval and Chapel Street public schools which the board no longer plans to use. The Halton board has indicated that it still intends to sell the school properties despite the town's request ownership of both properties at a nominal sum. The town is hoping to turn both schools into community recreational centres.

Milton was the first municipality to reply to the request for support. They offered a definite no which Oakville later agreed with. However, Burlington voted to support Halton Hills' stand against the board.
