

May hire consultants

Halton is considering hiring R. V. Anderson and Associates to design and supervise the construction of the addition to the Acton Sewage treatment plant.

D. J. Corbett, acting director of public works for the region, reported to regional council recently that the ministry of the environment, after studying the assimilative capacity of Black Creek, has recommended that the Acton plant capacity be increased to one million gallons per day.

"Under the circumstances," Mr. Corbett noted, "there would seem to be no reason why we should not, at this time, engage consultants for this project."

He noted that R. V. Anderson and Associates had been involved with the Acton plant for many years and is presently engaged on the design of phosphorous removal facilities for the plant.

Mr. Corbett's recommendations have been tabled pending a meeting of R. V. Anderson and Associates and representatives from the ministry of the environment.

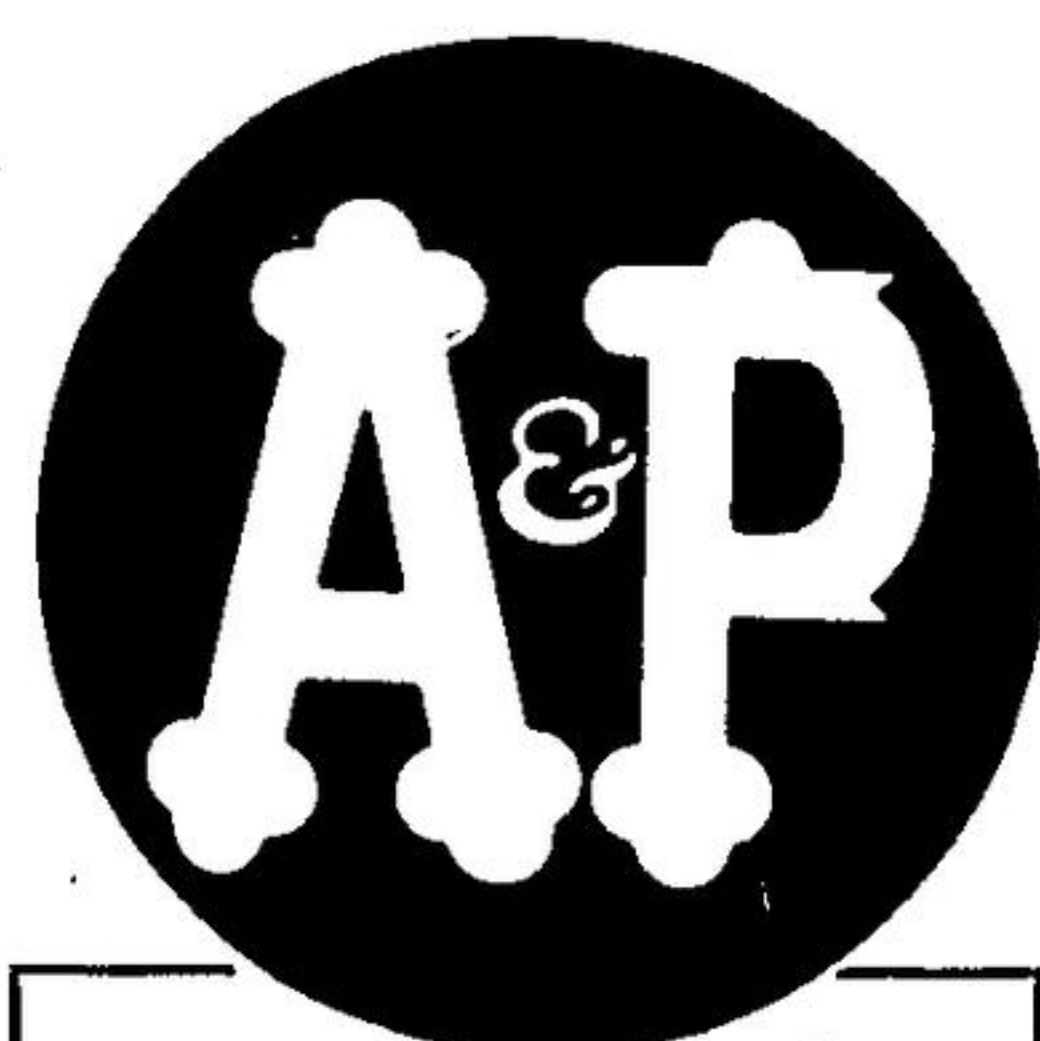

Poaching A Chicken

Most "leftover" chicken dishes taste better if they are made from poached chicken. If you have leftover roasted, broiled or fried chicken choose a leftover dish with a sauce or broth base.

Poaching chicken is easy. Simmer in water in a covered pot with a stalk of celery, an onion and a little salt until tender. Strain the broth and reserve it. Cut the chicken meat from the bones in generous slices. Any unused portion of the poached chicken may be stored in an air-tight container in the refrigerator or freezer for later use.
