

## Town joins fight

Halton Hills is not alone in its stand against the unlicensed use of "Mopeds" or motorized bicycles on public thoroughfares.

The town's clerk-administrator, Doug Pritchard, told the personnel and finance committee Monday night that he had received a request for support from the city of Sudbury in its fight against the vehicles.

At its last meeting the committee had asked Mr. Pritchard to contact the provincial government to see if there is any legislation which would allow Halton Hills to license the vehicles. Under present regulations the vehicles can be driven by anyone over 14-years-old, without a helmet and without insurance.

Thus far Mr. Pritchard has not heard back from the province thus blocking the committee from taking any steps against the vehicles.

Before adding its expected support to the Sudbury motion the committee will await the report from the government.

## Milton alone

Milton will get no support from Halton Hills in its appeal to the province concerning the disposition of assets resulting from the regional takeover by Oakville of a large portion of Milton.

Milton has claimed that the money it received from Oakville was not enough in light of the land and material lost in the takeover. An Ontario Municipal Board hearing is scheduled for June 9 in Milton to hear Milton's request for a change in the arbitrators' report.

As a result of the small change in boundaries affecting Halton Hills this town was paid \$280 by Oakville to compensate for its loss. Because the amount was so small the town's personnel and finance committee has agreed that Halton Hills should not become involved in the dispute between Milton and the region.

## Returns from Nova Scotia

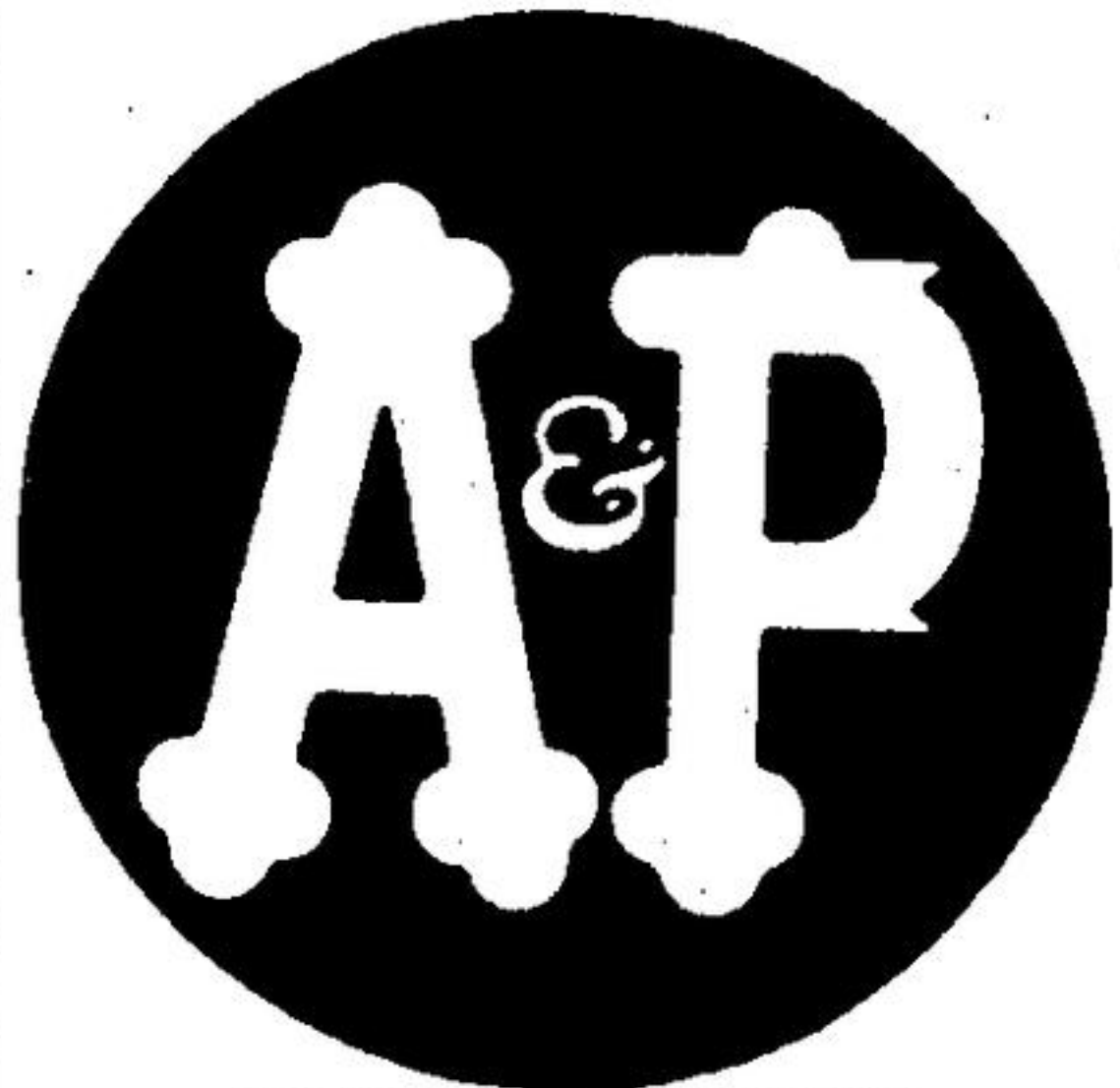
