# One dump for Halton is out

Halton Region have dumped their initial plans to develop one large landfill site to handle the garbage from all four regional municipalities, as had been proposed for a site in the Ashgrove area.

Instead the region may be looking shortly for two separate landfill sites; one in the south to handle the garbage from Oakville and Burlington and one in the north Halton Hills and Milton's refuse.

Regional councillor Len Coxé told Halton

Hills council last week that he's predicting now that those will be the recommendations of a consultants' report on garbage disposal in Halton which is due within the month.

"It should be coming back to us by the end of August or the first of September," said Coxé.

He noted that the report will likely specify that any garbage dumps would have to be located on Grade 3 agricultural land or less.

"Milton's trying to have one established

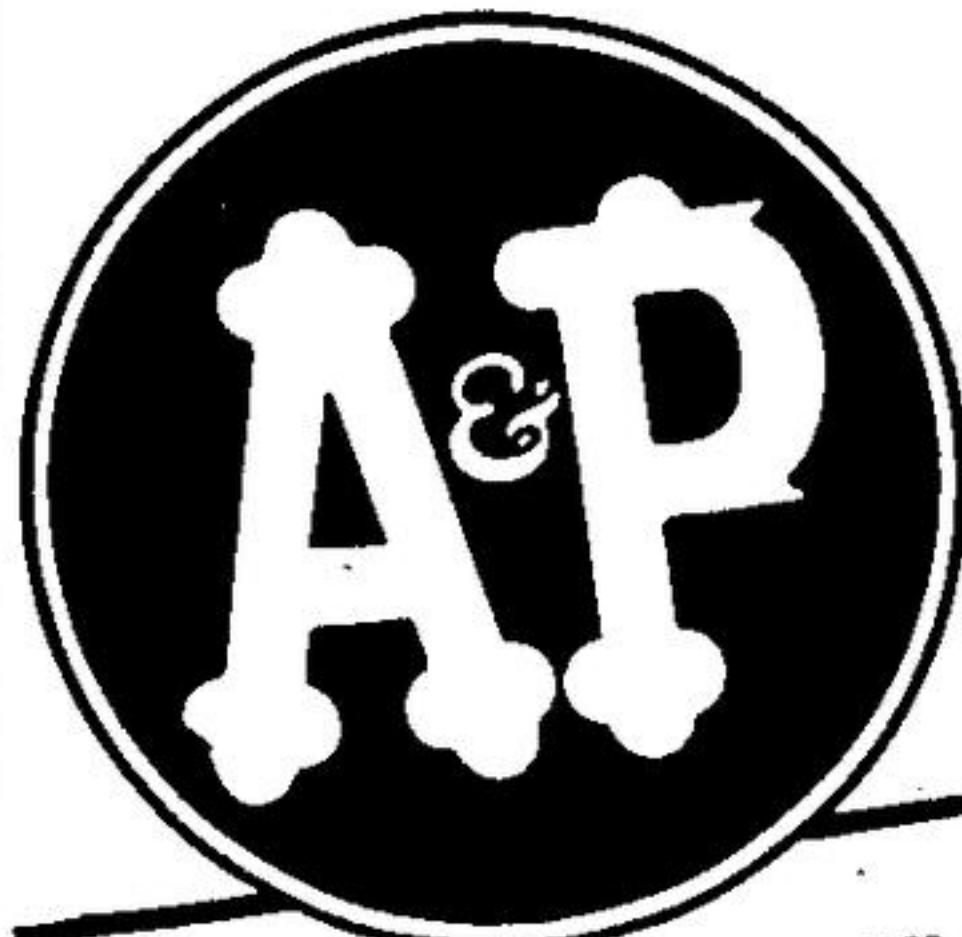
in the old Milton brickyards but the life of any site there would be very brief. However it could give Milton and the region the breathing spell they need while another alternative is found."

As of September 1 all garbage from Milton, Acton and Georgetown will be going into the Georgetown dump and that has upset Halton Hills councillors. They have sent a letter to the region's public works committee protesting "the Georgetown landfill site being filled with garbage brought from

outside Georgetown."

Coxé noted that Milton would likely support Georgetown's stand. "They're no more pleased about this arrangement than we are. After all they can't help but be upset about having to transport their garbage uphill to Georgetown."

Council unanimously supported the decision to send a letter of protest to the region about the over-use of the Georgetown landfill site. "We are definitely going to get some sort of response to the objections," commented Coxé.
