

# Recommends buying Glen Williams park

Pending a report submitted by Halton Hills Recreation Director, Doug Collison, the general administration committee will recommend to council that the town hire an appraiser to value the Cliff Davidson property in Glen Williams.

The 22 acres of land includes two baseball diamonds which are extensively used by Glen Williams. It was recommended that the town consider purchasing the property for recreation purposes.

At Monday night's general administration committee meeting Mayor Tom Hill praised the report submitted by Doug Collison concerning various aspects of the Davidson property.

"This is one of the best reports I have ever seen come out of the recreation department," complimented Mayor Hill.

Mr. Collison explained that the report examined four main areas concerning the Davidson property in lines of recreational purposes. Mr. Collison noted that all of the present Georgetown baseball diamonds, are being used to the maximum and that it would be almost impossible to fit the Glen's schedule into the Georgetown facilities.

also looked into the area of finding other suitable and available sites for such a development in the Glen. Mr. Collison explained that the department identified one other possible site, however, the town would be looking at a minimum expenditure of \$50,000 which would not include the cost of purchasing the property.

The report illustrated that, at present, there are approximately 15 acres of land undeveloped on the Davidson property and that this area could be developed into a passive picnic area. Mr. Collison also noted that there is an extreme shortage in the Georgetown area of soccer fields and baseball diamonds. The property in the Glen could be developed into the needed facilities.

At the present time the town does not own any other property which could be used for recreational development. Then, of course, there is the financial end of the matter. Thus an appraiser will look over the land and state its value.

Mr. Collison recommended in his report that the town purchase the entire property, then separate the property and sell the house and barn. Mr. Collison explained that the recreation department could

not see any need for keeping the buildings.

An appraiser will be made of the entire 22 acres and another appraisal made of the property excluding the house, barn and three or four acres surrounding the buildings.
